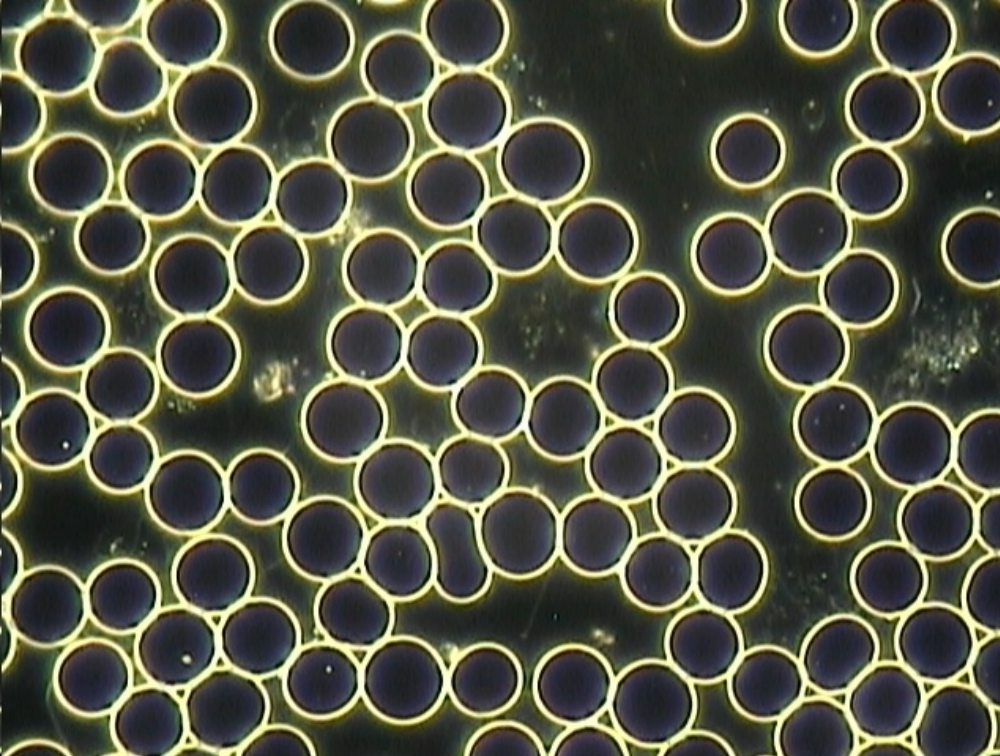
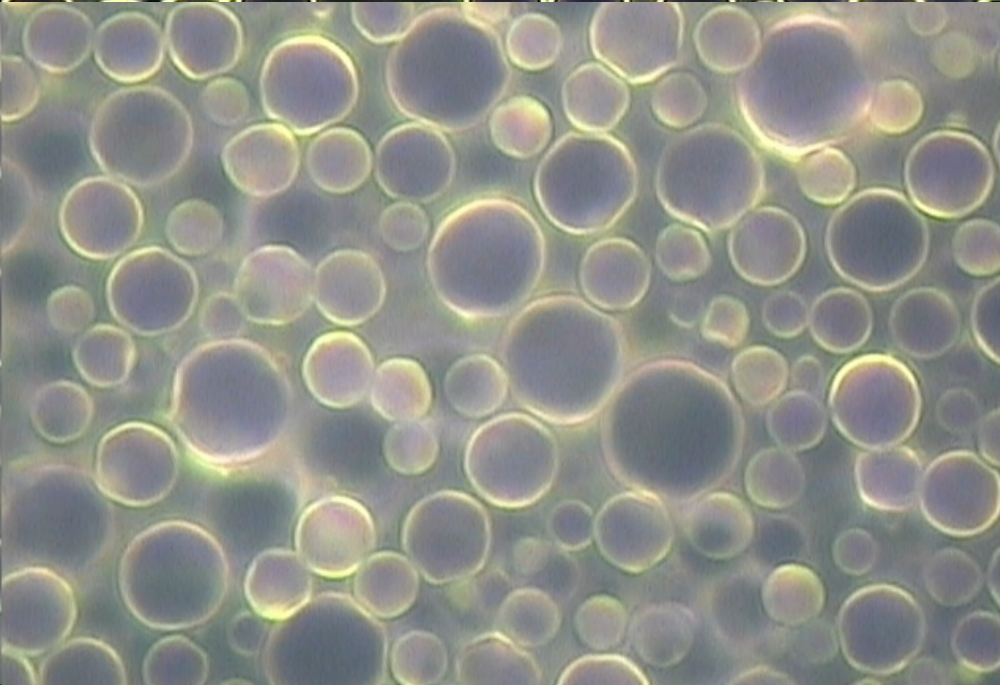


See for yourself... Raw milk is alive!

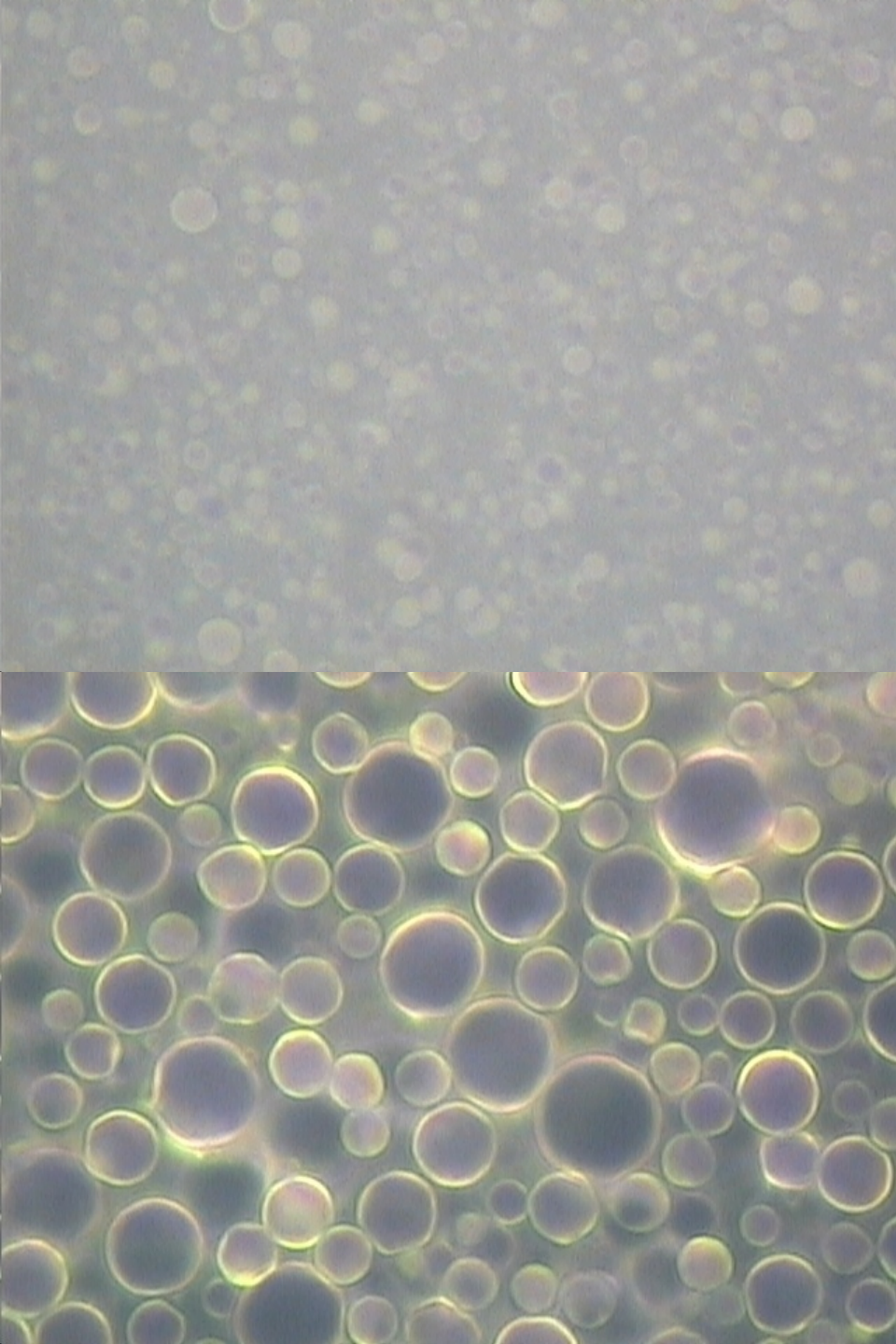
- If you ever wondered if there was a difference between processed milk and raw milk, these pictures show say it all.
- Raw milk is alive, just like our own blood.
- The processed milk pictures show a smooth, fine-textured matrix. Cells are uniformly broken up and lysed by heat, exposing the allergy-triggering internal cell proteins.
