It is understood that the dog belongs to HHDR and the foster MUST fill out an adoption application if they decide to adopt their foster and it must be approved prior to finalizing said adoption.
Foster agrees to go to events
Foster agrees to go to take foster dog to designated vets for vaccines and spay/neuter appointments
Fosters can only use designated vets unless given approval
Fosters will return all items back to the rescue when their foster is adopted
Fosters will provide rescue with photos and bio of their foster dog in order to get their dog posted for adoption
Foster agrees to get a photo of their foster dog with his or her new family before they leave their home
Foster agrees to conduct meet and greets and home visits
If a trainer comes to work with your foster dog you agree to follow instructions provided by the trainer.
You agree to give one of the Rescue Directors reasonable prior notification if your dog requires the following: a temporary foster home, more food or other supplies, needs help getting to a vaccine/spay/neuter appoint, etc.
If you cannot stay at an adoption event the entire time, the foster is responsible for coordinating drop off/pick up with whomever is volunteering at the adoption event. Dogs must attend as many adoption events as possible. We have these every Saturday of the month, events are usually only two hours long and are conducted between the hours of 11-3pm.
You agree to never physically harm your foster dog; this includes but not limited to slapping, pulling harshly on the dogs leash, keeping them locked in a crate for extended periods of time, etc. If your dog is expressing behavioral issues, you agree to notify the rescue directors immediately, so a training session can be scheduled.
If there is am issue with your new foster and you require the dog to be removed from your home; foster agrees to give the rescue at least 7 days to find a new foster home. Please note that if a foster is willing to swap dogs, it can help speed up the process to remove the current foster dog. HHDR does not have a facility, so a new foster home must be found for your current foster dog before he/she can be removed. This sometimes takes a little time, but rarely exceeds 7 days.
