Visual Arts Eligibility & Requirements

All aspects of the visual arts contest will be held in person with artwork being dropped off at Beck Center and the traditional exhibition taking place in the Beck Center Gallery as well as online.

- Students who are homeschooled or attending a high school in Lakewood or Rocky River are eligible to participate.
- All work submitted must be original art class assignments.
- There is a limit of 15 submissions per teacher and no more than two items per student.
- All entry forms must be completed and taped to the submitted work on the upper left-hand corner on the back of each piece.
- The Beck Center reserves the right to reject any piece that is deemed inappropriate in nature.
- Teachers are asked to submit all 2-D work in a brown portfolio. Please mark the portfolio with the name of the school and instructor.
- All 3-D work must be securely wrapped and labeled with the name of the school and instructor.
- The First-Place winner from 2021 Visual Arts contest is not eligible to win in this category in 2022.
- Artwork from previous years is not permitted and will be disqualified.
- The decision of the judges is final.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Care should be taken to properly finish works, including fixative for pastel or charcoal works, and varnish for paintings.
- Two-dimensional work must be appropriately matted on black or white matboard with secure reinforced backing. Works not meeting this requirement may be disqualified from the competition.
- Three-dimensional work may not exceed more than 36 inches in any direction.
- All paintings on canvas or canvas board should come wired and ready to hang.
- Items that are not appropriately prepared for display may be disqualified.
- All artwork will be photographed to be placed in an online exhibition.
