Time to Change the Rules

We are already working with lawyers, politicians and governments towards amending the most powerful legal document in the world - the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court - to make ECOCIDE an international crime. We also work with corporate leaders, NGOs, indigenous and faith groups, academic experts and grassroots campaigns to develop cross-sector support for this law.

Legal Definition of Ecocide

“ECOCIDE” means unlawful or wanton acts committed with knowledge that there is a substantial likelihood of severe and either widespread or long-term damage to the environment being caused by those acts.
