THOUGHT FOR TODAY

In JOHN 1:5 we read, **and the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.** This, my family, is a picture of someone not receiving the love of God and what light or revelation makes available for all. This verse makes it abundantly clear that our willingness to practice the love of God found in us must come from a place of personal revelation of its need, not with preconceived ideas of how it is to be received. Let me say it this way, you can't force the love of God or help people receive it, it must simply be released from the heart. Just like our personal "suddenly" caught us in a position of receptivity, so it happens for all. Unfortunately, we see in this verse that those bound by darkness will not comprehend the light they're exposed to. Consequently our part is to practice love by believing for their "suddenly" opportunity by praying **Ephesians 1:18, The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints.** This is practicing love behind the scenes; believing the light will come on because again, you can't force that in anyone's life and the Father definitely won't.

Alright, we're first going to look at the phrase **Be not deceived; God is not mocked**. The Amplified says, **Do not be deceived and deluded and misled; God will not allow Himself to be sneered at (scorned, disdained, or mocked by mere pretensions or professions, or by His precepts being set aside.)** What's interesting about the words **deceived, deluded, and misled** is they are all definitions of one another. So we're seeing in this relatively short verse a principle that honestly can affect everything we believe, say and do. That may sound a little radical, but let me interrupt this with a verse that deals with the importance of the Word in its entirety. In **LUKE 4:4** Jesus tells us, **And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God**. Based on this verse just how important is every word? The Word makes that clear in many places and I'm sure the more we have revelation the more of the kingdom of heaven we'll experience HERE and NOW. Because the Father is in charge of honoring His Word we must realize that He and He alone is going to see to it that our words take us where we belong and no one can stop it but us.

Because God looks on the heart and not the outward appearance or skill, God will not honor that which doesn't emanate from a sincere, humble heart. This my family is the difference between life and death, victory and defeat in this life. Remember, heaven comes to earth for those who believe and do what heaven commands. In other words, it's in spirit and truth we are heard and receive what belongs to us from the Father who wants us to freely have all things.
