### **OUTREACH**

Sign-up for Outreach Service Day 2019: Sunday, October 27 Jesus calls us to help build a bigger table where everyone belongs. Each day in our city, thousands of men, women, and children don't have enough food to eat. Building a bigger table means providing food and nourishment for those in need.On Outreach Service Day, after the 10:30am service, we'll pack emergency food kits for 1,000 families in our surrounding neighborhoods.
