When I would happen upon those who were, only days earlier, unknown to one another and yet tending to each other's spiritual and emotional trials, I couldn't help but think of the spirit of the human person imitating, in its highest form, the Holy Spirit of God.

These words are from Eric Girten, Director of Family and Life for the Diocese of Evansville, reflecting on the graces received from hosting the Life-Giving Wounds retreat in August this year. Your incredible support and the outpouring of blessings from the Holy Spirit is what makes this possible!

Allow us to share some highlights from 2022 and the ambitious plans Life-Giving Wounds has for 2023! We humbly ask you to review and consider supporting our mission through a generous year-end donation.

• Continuing growth coast-to-coast – Thanks to you, Life-Giving Wounds has expanded from our one original Washington, D.C. chapter to 10 total chapters, in partnership with 12 dioceses. Life-Giving Wounds chapters are now literally coast-to-coast, from California to Florida to New York and more! AND we have plans to expand to another 6+ new locations in 2023. Each new chapter brings more in-person support to local ACODs!



• Healing souls and forming missionary disciples – Life-Giving Wounds started with a team of only four volunteers, and now we have over 100 volunteer leaders in our ministry, almost all of whom are alumni, helping to heal the wounds of others like themselves. Thanks in large part to their dedication and hard work, we have grown from intensively serving just 10 adult children of divorce or separation in our first year to providing unique, in-depth pastoral care to over 400 ACODs in 2022. We continue to offer robust ministry programs, both in-person and online. And next year we have plans to create online courses, a group mentorship program, and much more.

Increasing witness and amplifying ACOD voices - We published a record number of posts on the Life-Giving Wounds blog this year, which includes 100+ testimonies, expert advice pieces, and more. We also reached well over three hundred thousand people through our website and social media channels, and we spoke about ACOD needs on podcasts and other media, including an EWTN show. We plan to amplify the voices of ACODs even more next year, through the launch of a speakers' bureau, the publication of our **first-ever** *full-length book*, and continued high-quality, insightful blog and social media posts.
