Individuals will then be asked to create an account.

The participating organization is US Soccer.

All participating adults and minors are required to complete training videos prior to September 1, 2019. Participating adults and minors include: Contractors, volunteer referees, any paid staff (i.e.: personal trainers, massage therapist, office staff)

- SafeSport completion certificates will be required for participation.
- Required to be verified by the organization administrator.
- Training is required annually.
