Bijoux Falls is located just off of Highway 97 and the falls are visible from the parking lot.







Bijoux Falls

Located in the Pine Pass, there are numerous recreational opportunities to enjoy when visiting Bijoux Falls. Bijoux Falls is technically closed for the winter, but other winter activities include snowmobiling along the Murray Ridge or Bijoux Falls park, ski/snowboarding at Powder King Ski Resort, ski touring up Ralston Creek, or ice climbing the numerous waterfalls in the area.

In the summer, visitors enjoy the Pine Le Moray Provincial Park, Azouzetta Lake and campground, hike Murray Ridge and numerous hunting and fishing opportunities off the beaten path.

Directions to Trailhead

From Mackenzie Junction, travel North on hwy 97 for 32km, the parking lot is on the left.

From Powder King Ski Resort, travel for 6.7km South on hwy 97, the parking lot will be on the right.
