Class Types

Foundation | Courses include grammar, vocabulary and practice! Once or twice a week for 3 hours.

Uses the Cosmopolite method.

Cost: \$455 for 10 weeks (\$15/hr) + \$80 materials.

Intensive | Courses meet several times a week to cover foundation materials at a faster pace. Duration and prices vary. \$80 materials.

Conversation | Classes improve your speaking skills. Once a week for 2 hours. No textbook used. Cost: \$335 for 10 weeks (\$16.50/hr). \$200 for 5 weeks (\$19.50/hr).

Review | Classes are ideal for brushing up after a break or consolidating points learned. Once a week for 2 hours. No textbook used. Cost: \$200 for 5 weeks (\$19.50/hr).

Workshops & Topics | Classes allow students to focus on specialized themes related to grammar, literature or Francophone culture. Duration and prices vary.
