With a number of peak weeks across the summer, our nation's love affair with animals has never been so apparent, although it was this week's international story of Pen Farthing's rescue of his shelter animals out of Kabul that helped boost **unique users by +37%** this week to 1.2m



Whether it's Netflix announcing 42 new films for Q4 or Marvel dropping the most watched trailer ever for Spiderman: No Way Home, the **+42% week on week growth in Movies page views and +35% increase in readers**, proves the ongoing allure of the latest news from the silver screen

MUSIC TOPS THE BILL THIS WEEK



+59% more page views than average

This week's figures represent the second highest for the Music & Audio category in 2021 - with **+59% more page views than the average of the past 4 months**, and +54% more unique users

+75% unique user weekly growth

The relative consistency of the Music & Audio category is boosted by **distinct peaks around key event periods**; e.g. Glastonbury Live streaming and Eurovision in late May or this week's festival boost

2.6m Rock Music PVs this week

Demonstrating the eclectic tastes of the UK population, the top two genres of music content consumed this week were **Rock Music and Pop Music, each with c.2.6m page views and 900k+ readers**
