CLUB/PLAYER/PARENT AGREEMENT

Since being established in 2015, the Idaho Juniors United FC have experienced tremendous success both locally and regionally. We have learned the importance of clear and consistent communication between club, teams, coaches, players, and parents. This agreement is explaining in detail the expectations of the IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC staff and our members. _____ Int.

TEAM TRYOUTS

Team tryouts will be held annually for players who meet age requirements. The club will announce team tryouts to inform the public of specific tryout dates and times. All players that come out will be evaluated and determined to be a good fit for the teams within the club. _____ Int.

THE PLAYER

Once you commit to joining IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC, you agree to abide by the policies of the club and your team. **This commitment is for the entire 2023-2025 seasonal year. The soccer season begins August 1st, 2023 – July 31st, 2024, for all Juniors teams.** At the end of the soccer season (July 31st, 2024) your commitment to the club is over and you are free to join another club should you choose. At the beginning of the following soccer season, a player is once again free to tryout under the conditions stated above. Once your commitment is made, the club expects your full participation and support for the entire soccer season. The commitments of your player are mandatory weekly training sessions, mandatory games, mandatory winter training, and mandatory tournaments which are further discussed below. No player will be released from a team during the soccer season unless it is for disciplinary reasons or failure to fulfill club financial obligations.

TOURNAMENT PLAY

During the season, teams will participate in a minimum of 4 tournaments. Member participation in all team tournaments is mandatory and non-negotiable. The decision as to which tournaments the team will play in will be discussed at each team's annual parent meeting. All team costs are the responsibility of the



team. The player and his parents are responsible for the cost of the player's travel, accommodations, and meals. The cost of the team coach's travel, accommodations, meals and/or per diem will be paid for by the players and their parents. Tournament costs will be divided evenly amongst the registered players on the team regardless of an individual player's attendance at the tournament. Should your son not attend planned tournaments, you will be expected to pay your portion to cut down on costs of other parents.

THE PARENTS

Parental support and involvement in the club is essential. If your son is selected and chooses to commit himself to the IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FUTBOL CLUB, parental commitment is also necessary. This means making sure your son is at all games, trainings, tournaments outside of medical or family emergencies. _____ Int.

THE 24-HOUR RULE POLICY

Parents/guardians are not allowed to confront a coach, team, or league official to discuss any “negative” game or practice situation with the coaching and management staff until at least 24 hours has passed from the completion of the game or practice. A confrontation consists of any conversation, which is elevated from a normal speaking tone and demeanor to one which involves yelling, profanity, or derogatory comments toward said coach, team, or league official. Violation of the 24-Hour Rule Policy will result in disciplinary actions. _____ Int.

THE COACH

The coaches for the IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC are instructed to conduct themselves first as teachers/role models and then soccer coaches. Expect all IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC Coaches to conduct themselves as positive role models and be the example with positive behavior(s). Our coaches understand the significance their actions play in young people's lives. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of the team on and off the soccer field when the team is together and part of club events. _____ Int.

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

So that players and parents in our club can get the maximum benefit, the club requires all to abide by club rules, regulations, and policies. If disciplinary actions are necessary, the following steps may be taken: The team coach and/or club President and Vice President will discuss the problem directly and privately with the player with the expectation the problem will be corrected immediately. If the problem persists the team coach and/or club President and Vice President will communicate with the player's parents to discuss the issue. If the problem continues, the club President, Vice President, and/or team coach may temporarily suspend the player. If the situation warrants, the club President may recommend to the Board



of Directors that the player be removed from the club. The Board of Directors will notify the parents of the recommendation. The parents of any player recommended for removal from the club may request to meet with the Board of Directors and the club President. _____ Int.

IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC CLUB DUES PAYMENT POLICIES

IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC families will have the option of paying the 2023-2024 Player Dues in one lump sum or in payments. All payments will be made through TeamSnap. **There will be a 3% charge for all credit or debit card transactions through TeamSnap.** Please see below for cost and payment schedules. Late Payment Fees:

A \$10.00 late payment fee will be assessed each time a payment is received past the due dates described above or noted on the Player Dues schedule. _____ Int.



Payment Default:

Any player in default when payments are delinquent past 10 days. Any player delinquent in club dues and team fees will be notified by the club. To prevent players from being prohibited from participating in any club competition and membership privileges, please contact club Treasurer Carolyn Mauritzson at idahojrscftreasurer@gmail.com to discuss payment options. _____ Int.

Refund Policy:

A player who drops after signing the Letter of Intent, but before training begins may be eligible for a refund of 50% of the total player's dues already collected by the club. After the start of training no refunds will be granted to any player who drops prior to the end of their season commitment. _____ Int.

Injury Policy:

In order to receive a partial refund of dues paid due to an injury, 1) the player must have been injured while playing or practicing as part of an IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC sanctioned event, and 2) the player must have missed four (4) or more months of the club season (the high school season does not count as part of the club season). _____ Int.

Financial Aid:

IDAHO JUNIORS UNITED FC is proud to be able to offer scholarship opportunities for players and families in need. In order to be considered for scholarships, players' parents need to fill out Financial Aid Application. At that time Idaho Juniors United FC club leadership will determine eligibility of players. _____ Int.
