He initially studied Physics and Arabic Language and Literature at the Universities of Heidelberg, Berlin and Oxford, before traveling around the Mediterranean in 2005 to do a TV documentary for an Arab broadcaster. After a short time in the free economy he completed the directing class at the University of Television and Film in Munich. In 2009 Peter Baranowski co-founded the production company Passanten Filmproduktion together with Michael Krummenacher. Since then he has directed several short films. Among them RAUSCHGIFT (ADDICTED) which won the Pardino d'Oro for the best international shortfilm at IFF Locarno 2011 and BIS ICH ES WEISS (UNTIL I KNOW) which was screened at IFF Toronto 2014. The feature documentary THE TEMPERATURE OF WILL about his brother's work as a Catholic priest premiered at IFF Munich in 2017 and was in German cinemas 2018. In 2019 Peter Baranowski founded the Munich based production company Rohstoff Film GmbH.
