INTERFAITH SPEAKERS WANTED: NO EXPERIENCE REQUIRED!

INTERFAITH ATLANTA (IA) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit with roots going back nearly four decades. IA promotes understanding, respect, prayer, interaction and unity among the diverse faiths in the greater Atlanta region, to advance the influence of voices of the faith communities for the common good. IA's five goals are: Advocacy and Action; Communal Prayer; Dialogue; Cooperation and Networking; and Education on Religion.

To foster the Education Goal, IA, through its INTERFAITH SPEAKERS NETWORK (ISN) provides a 60 or 90 minute panel presentation to audiences from middle schoolers to seniors. We provide opportunities to hear and interact with a panel of local practicing representatives from six faith traditions: Christianity, Islam and Judaism (the Abrahamic faiths) and Buddhism, Hinduism and Sikhi (the Eastern faiths). The panels are educational, interactional and facilitate dialogue and understanding between different religions. In addition to sharing information, ISN panels showcase ways that different faith traditions can work together.


