

# IN MARCH 2021

This survey was compiled from more than **1,149 people** who received a clinical diagnosis of the herpes simplex virus (Primarily Type 1 or Type 2). Courtney W. Brame, founder of Something Positive for Positive People (SPFPP), developed these survey questions from his podcast guests and listeners.


All survey questions were chosen because these are the most common among people living with herpes. This is the information that, at the time, people wish they had more up to date stats on. This survey does *not* speak to transmission rates. While that is useful information, it is not possible at this time for SPFPP to conduct that depth of research. This information was collected from people with herpes for people with herpes.

Responses were collected between May-June 2021, and the data released July 2021.








When you tested positive, did you have any symptoms (symptoms include what is commonly known as an outbreak)?








Where do your symptoms present themselves when you have an outbreak? (Check all that apply)



Before your diagnosis, did you know anyone living with HSV? (Check all that apply)



Did you have support from your partner post-diagnosis?



Did your health care provider offer you an opportunity to ask them any questions about your diagnosis?










# Have you had an outbreak since your initial diagnosis?








Did you think about committing suicide after your diagnosis?



# Did you attempt suicide after your diagnosis?



Have you seen a mental health professional because of your diagnosis?



Have you been diagnosed with depression related to your HSV status?



Have you tested positive for another STI since your herpes diagnosis?



Before your herpes diagnosis, did you test positive for an STI?



How long after your diagnosis did you feel prepared to disclose to a person without intending to have sex with them?









After disclosing your status to a partner from the past. with whom you were unaware of their status, did a sexual relationship resurface?










Before your diagnosis, did you know that oral herpes (commonly known as cold sores and fever blisters) could transmit to a partner's genitals from oral sex?

Before your diagnosis, did you know you could still get HSV even if you use condoms and dental dams (protective barriers for oral sex)



Before your diagnosis, did you ever inquire on your sexual partners' HSV status specifically?





Since your diagnosis, have you been sexually active with someone who does not have HSV?








Has a partner consented to sex with you without a condom or barrier since your diagnosis?








Are you currently, or have you been in a healthy committed relationship since your diagnosis?
