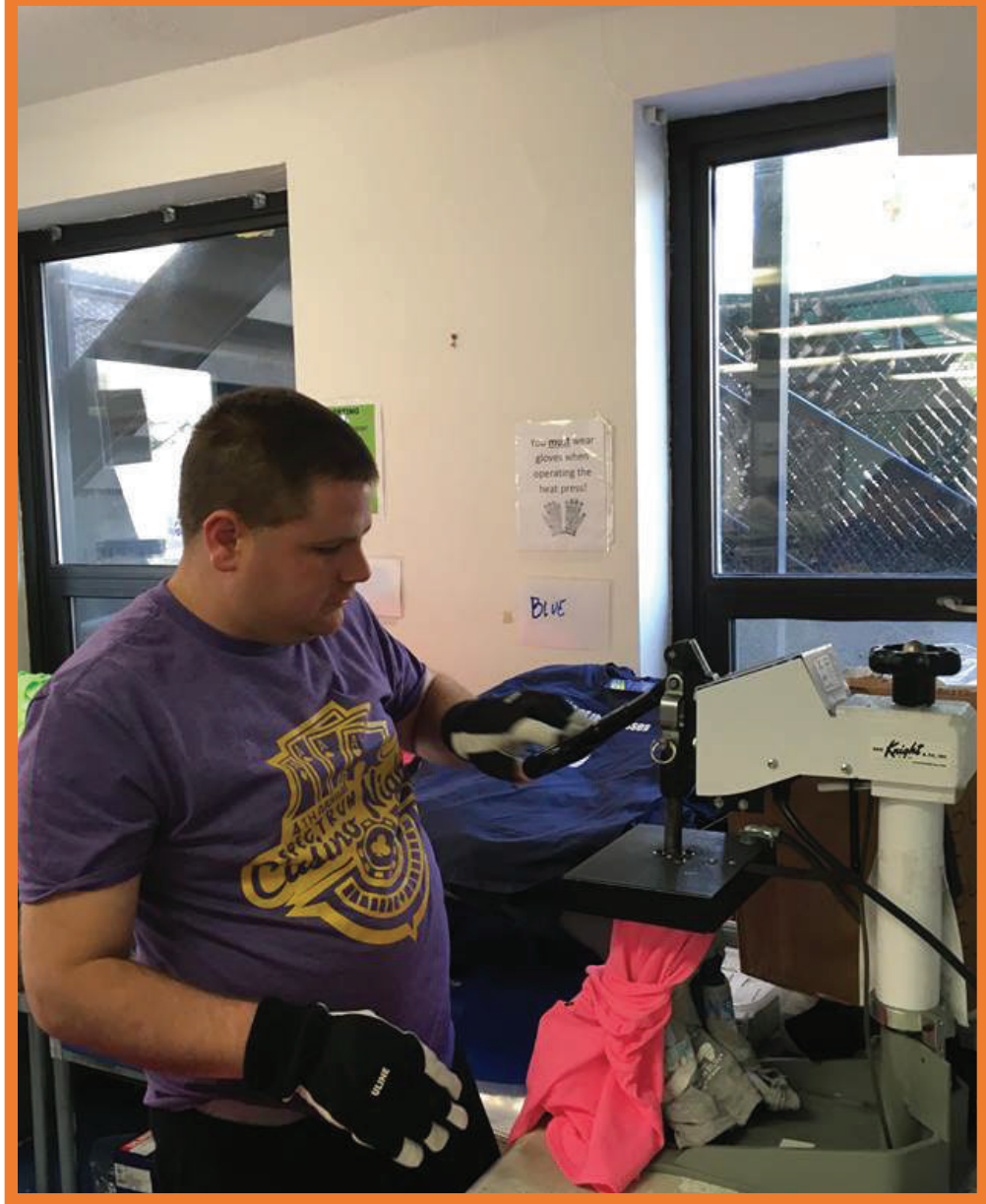

Letter From Our CEO/Co-Founder

Dear Friends,

2016 was another memorable year for Spectrum Designs and its affiliate businesses, Spectrum Bakes, Suds and Grows. While the affiliate businesses established brand identity and repeat customers, Spectrum Designs had its biggest year to date, growing almost 50% from the previous year. By adding \$500,000 in sales, the apparel business finished the year at over \$1.4m in gross sales. It also added several major new customers with the highlight being the first business of its kind to partner with Autism Speaks in their national walk program, printing and shipping over 54,000 shirts across all 50 states.

So why is this information important? Believe it or not, sales figures are not what drive us. Moreover, it's what they mean for our employee/trainee numbers. In 2016, Spectrum was able to offer 320 hours a week of paid employment to 19 young adults with Autism, this reflected a 130% increase on 2015. Further, in partnership with the Nicholas Center, an increase of 66% to 580 hours a week of authentic vocational training was provided to 31 high school students. This totaled Spectrum's outreach to over 60 individuals and their families in 2016, a 40% increase from the previous year. Quite simply; the more the businesses grow, the greater the volume of work needed and, with the support of the Nicholas Center, the wider we can open our doors to local teens and young adults with Autism. This is the guiding principle of what Spectrum Designs Foundation is, to grow sustainable businesses with a social mission which offer authentic vocational and gainful employment opportunities to a population that has historically been underestimated and under-served .

Undoubtedly, it is a combination of growing sales and an incredibly supportive donor base of friends, family and community that has driven us forward at such pace. During 2016, the possibility of purchasing the building became more tangible, and the Believe Capital Expansion Campaign received many donations from families, organizations, and businesses wanting to support our mission. After much discussion and negotiations, the sale price and terms to purchase 366 Main Street were agreed upon, and contracts signed; a 7,400 sq.ft. building just steps away from our current location.

We are blessed with some of the most incredible families and friends who share our vision of a brighter future for people with Autism. This building is a dream come true for all of us, not just Stella, Nicole and I.



Finally, to Zach Fishbein. Thank you for the time you shared with us. Thank you for your hard work, your passion and your infectious smile. Always happy and welcoming in life, we can't wait to welcome visitors to our new building through the Zachary Fishbein Welcome Lobby. You showed us what Spectrum Designs can and should be, and you will always be with us.

This year, Spectrum Designs was honored at the annual Landmark on Main Street Gala. To share our story with the Port Washington community was another stellar moment in the short history of our organization.

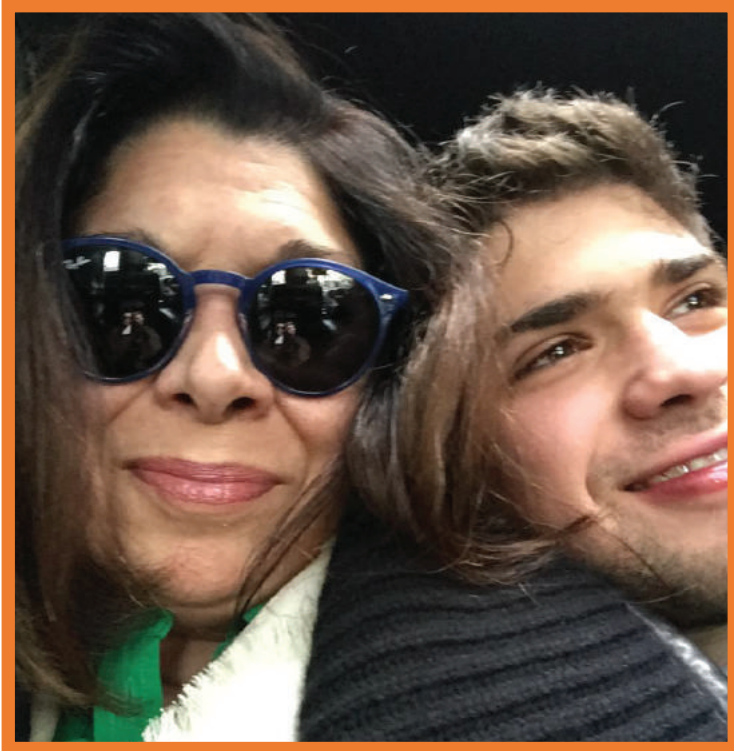

Social Enterprises

Expansion - Increasing Employment

At Spectrum Designs we envision ever-expanding programs beyond our current focus which will allow a lifetime of sustainability, fulfillment and purpose for adults affected with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Spectrum Designs along with its partner agency Nicholas Center expanded their work training programs two years ago and launched three small businesses as “social enterprises” Spectrum Bakes, Spectrum Suds and Spectrum Grows. These enterprises build on the employment strengths of adults with Autism, provide a positive prevocational work environment, internal support and the skills necessary to successfully cross the road into adulthood.



The Spectrum Bakes team offers a variety of handmade, customizable granola based products. We are busy growing our business and providing our delicious treats for corporate events, bridal showers, engagement parties and weddings. Our granola treats are also being sold in local stores such as Harbor Deli and Sweet Treats on the Wharf. Spectrum Bakes launched a new website and online store. Our baked goods can also be found on the Etsy website. Customers who have already loved our granola include Victory Packaging, MWM Foundation, MD VIP, Do It for the Love Foundation, and North Shore Autism Circle. Our granola has been featured at events for the Landmark on Main Street and Plandome Ladies Golf Association.



Spectrum Grows is continuing to grow and deliver to Northwell Hospital in Manhasset and has expanded its product line to include dried herb packets. The growing team has been busy harvesting, washing and dehydrating and packaging a variety of herbs, in addition to germinating and watering micro-greens on a weekly basis.



The team at Spectrum Suds continues to offer concierge laundering services for customers within the local community. The Suds team has become more independent in completing the laundry process from start to finish. This year the Nicholas Center is purchasing a vehicle for our free pick up and drop off services. Our client list continues to grow as we focus on more local marketing.

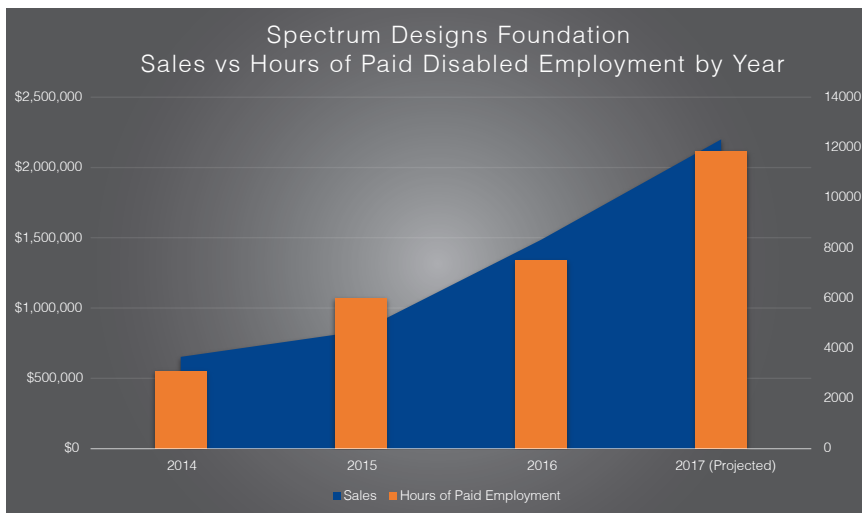

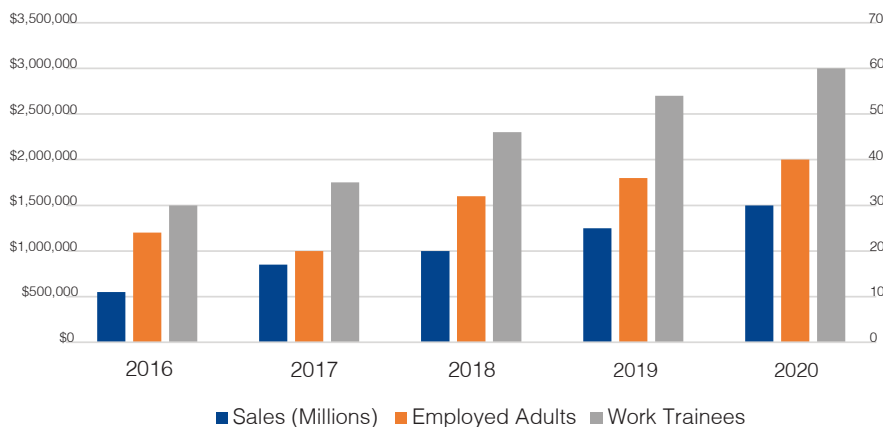

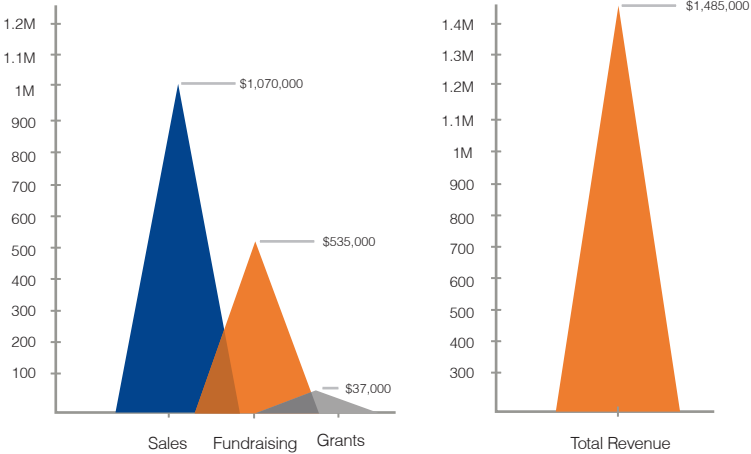


Impact of Sales on Spectrum Job Creation

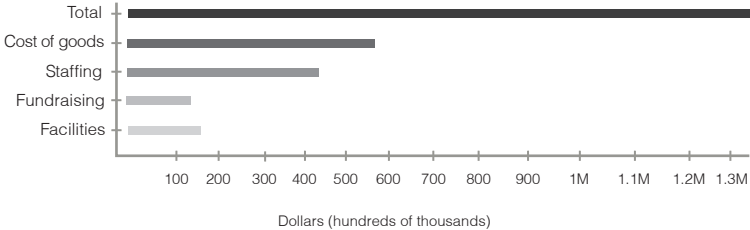

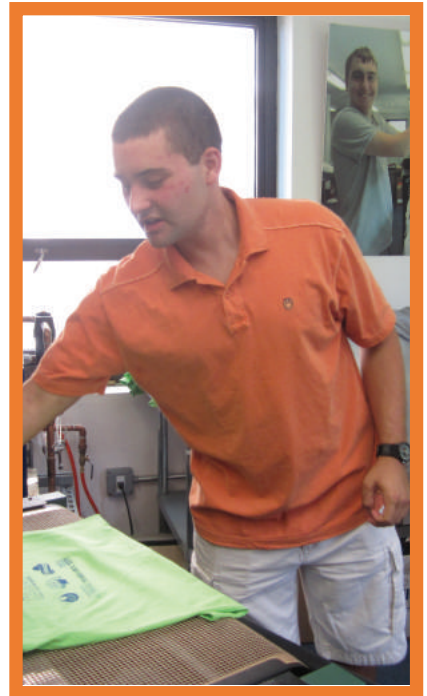
