
SPECIAL EVENTS

Spectrum Designs raised more than \$300,000 in 2015 from it's special events. 
In 2015 we launched the Believe Capital Campaign. It became clear to us that we were quickly outgrowing our current facility. The purpose was and is to raise \$2 million to purchase a permanent home for Spectrum Designs and its ancillary social enterprises; Spectrum Grows, Spectrum Bakes and Spectrum Suds. More square feet of operating space will expand our existing businesses and enable us to do even more to help the growing need for authentic employment and work related opportunities for people with autism.

In 2015 we raised a total of \$89,046 towards this campaign which gave us a strong start for 2016.
























BELIEVE CAMPAIGN APPEAL
