Standing together as co-founders in Stella's backyard barn in February 2011, I am not sure Nicole, Stella, or I ever could have imagined what would exist a decade later. In 2021, we celebrated the 10-year anniversary of both Spectrum Designs and The Nicholas Center and while the celebrations were muted by the ongoing pandemic, the sense of pride and accomplishment was felt fully amongst our team, board, families, and supporters - all of whom are the reason we have moved beyond the barn!



Despite the continuing impact of Covid-19, Spectrum's enterprises all experienced growth and expansion in 2021. Our newly renovated Westchester location sprung to life, generating 8 new jobs and reaching over 300,000 imprints in the first year! Spectrum Designs' Port Washington location thrived also, adding 6 new jobs and slowly but surely shifting away from PPE orders back to apparel and promotional items. Spectrum Suds added 95 new (repeat) clients, created new employment and training opportunities, and averaged over 1,000 lbs. of laundry per week! Finally, Spectrum Bakes had a record-breaking holiday season, shipping out over 50,000 bars and bags of granola!

All of this activity of course, means increased revenue and reach, but more than anything, it's the impact on the lives of our neurodiverse employees and the trainees that we value most. Ironically, that can be the hardest thing to measure. Of course, we plot hours of employment, units sold, dollars fundraised, grants awarded, and they are a mark of a successful year. However, the impact of the intangible benefits of what we do can't be overlooked. The lifelong friendships made, the pride felt by the family, the confidence regained, the independence formed, the happiness and security. That is the magic. That's the stuff we could never have imagined a decade ago, and that's what will drive us into 2022 and beyond.


DECEMBER

All of Spectrum's employees were surveyed anonymously in late 2021.






My work has given me opportunities for *personal* growth

Over 81% of respondents replied with a 4 or 5




I feel confident in my abilities

Almost 79% of respondents replied with a 4 or 5








