Science Fair was successfully conducted on Apr-28th at Forest Hill Multipurpose room. This was a great staff+PTA activity, with over 100 students presenting 40+ projects. Student projects covered variety of topics in the fields of physics, chemistry & engineering, including renewal energy, worm composting, electricity generation with fruits, how humans perceive colors, sonar based object detection for disabled, magnetism, 3D printing and many more! Students worked hard for over 3 months preparing their projects, posters, followed by a great presentation to over 250 visitors that visited science fair this year. We also had many visitors from the neighborhood (not related to Forest Hill) this year, which turned it into a great community bonding event. Thanks to school staff for volunteering to be on the POG panel and providing constructive feedback to students about their projects. Special shout out to Alejandra A & Murgi M for volunteering and going above & beyond help participants on science fair day!

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


