## Preparing for September

Just a couple of reminders about the start of next term and preparations you will be making over the summer holiday.

### Uniform

Please make sure that any uniform you purchase is in line with the school requirements (see website). This may mean ignoring signs in some shops which say 'school uniform'. In particular:

- Shoes should be plain black – no patterns/logos
- Trousers should not be flared or tight fitting

Students will not be allowed into lessons if they are wearing incorrect uniform.

Just in case anyone has been persuaded to allow their son/daughter to have a new piercing over the holiday, we only allow a maximum of one stud in each ear. If students have other piercings (nose, tongue, etc.) they will not be allowed into lessons. Plastic sleeper studs are also not acceptable.

### Attendance and Punctuality

The school's expectation is that all students aim for attendance of 95% or above. Good attendance ensures that students give themselves the best chance of success – both in school and in later life. It also gives them the best opportunity to develop positive relationships at school.

The government classifies any students who have attendance of 90% or below, for whatever reason, as a persistent absentee. A student who has 90% attendance throughout years 7 – 11, will miss, in total, half a school year of their education.

We are not able to authorise any absences for holidays. We also do not authorise any periods of illness of longer than five days without specific medical evidence. Where there are particular concerns about attendance, we may request medical evidence for shorter periods of absence. There are legal implications if students have unauthorised absences from school.

We hope that all students will return to school in September with a real determination to aim for 100% attendance.

We also expect students to arrive to school and lessons on time. A few minutes late each day can have a big impact. We close our registers at 9am. Any students arriving after that time will have the morning session counted as an unauthorised absence, unless evidence (e.g. of a medical appointment) is provided.
