Opening

- How well do you typically deal with change and uncertainty? How is that coming out in this season?

Discussion

- Read [Matthew 6:31-34](#)
- Is Jesus saying that we are not allowed to worry about whether our needs will be met in the future, or that we don't need to worry? How do you know?
- What are some things you are worrying about right now? How do you respond to Jesus' teaching that your Heavenly Father knows what you need?
- What does it practically look like to seek God's Kingdom and righteousness in this season? How do we do that "first"?
- The "as well" in verse 33 implies that we receive, rather than earn, God's kingdom and righteousness. How has God given these to you? How can that give us confidence that He will give us the other things that we need?
- What is one good thing and one challenge that you personally tend to lose sight of when you start focusing too much on the future?

Closing

- Read [Matthew 7:9-11](#). As you pray, proclaim the fact that God is a loving Father who wants to provide for you. Then confidently ask him to meet your needs in this season.
