### Main Points

- Grace is “the goodness and power of God to change anyone’s life”
- Humility is “putting the interest of others ahead of your own”
- Teamwork is “believing that we can do more together than we can on our own”

### Opening

- What do you miss most about meeting together on Sundays?

### Discussion

- Read [Ephesians 2:1-10](#)
- What is the difference between being saved by grace and being saved by works?
- In what ways are we dead apart from Christ? Why would God make us alive when we’re dead because of our sins?
- What is the difference between a church that functionally believes that people are saved by grace through faith and a church that functionally believes that we are saved by our works?
- Read [Philippians 2:3-4](#).
- How would you define humility?
- How do you respond to C.S. Lewis’ quote, “Humility is not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less”?
- True humility can be a rare trait. Why do you think it’s so rare? How does grace enable someone to be truly humble?
- Read [1 Corinthians 12:12-14](#).
- How would you describe what “part of the body” you are? In other words, how do you fit in with the life and ministry of the larger church?
- What does it look like for you to \*need\* the other parts of the body?

### Closing

- Of each of these three core values, grace, humility, and teamwork, which is the most challenging for you personally? What is something you can do to grow in it?
