- In the Lion King, when Simba remembered whose son he was, he had a different perspective of himself and what he was capable of. How could understanding yourself as a son/daughter of God change your perspective of yourself?
- How could remembering that you are a son/daughter of God change your perspective of what you're capable of? How might it change your perspective on what you should be doing in life?
- What was it that drove Simba away from the Pridelands and from his identity? What in your life makes you want to run away from your identity as a son/daughter of God?
- Ryan mentioned that habitual sin is often more of an identity issue than a behavioral issue. What did he mean? Can you give an example?
- In what way could our lifestyle say more about whose we are than who we are? How do you respond to that idea?
