### Opening

- What is one thing that you own that you would consider priceless?

### Discussion

- [Read Matthew 6:19-21](#)
- On a scale of 1-10, how comfortable are you talking to others about money? Looking at this passage, why do you think Jesus felt so comfortable talking about money?
- We all have things that we would be afraid to lose. Is there anything in your life that you think might own you more than you owning it?
- Do you think being more generous than you currently are would make you more or less free? Why?
- [Read Matthew 6:22-24](#)
- Have you ever known someone who changed for the worse because they started prioritizing money or possessions over God and people? What was that like?
- You tend to be most generous with your money, time, or energy? Is there one that God is asking you to grow in?
- Why do you think it's impossible to serve both God and money? Is it possible to serve God while having lots of money? Why?

### Closing

- Jesus' purpose through the whole Sermon on the Mount is to help us live in the blessing of the Kingdom. Is there a next step you need to take in being financially generous that would allow you to experience more of the blessing of God?
