

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Astrology Practicum Starter Guide. This is the first part of a multi-step learning process designed to help you build a clear and grounded foundation in astrology.

This guide focuses on the symbols used in astrology—those of the planets, signs, and houses. Each symbol is a visual shorthand that carries a specific meaning. Learning to recognize these symbols is the first essential step in reading and interpreting astrological charts.

In this section, you will:

- Become familiar with the core symbols used in astrology
- Learn their basic associations and themes
- Begin to visually identify parts of a natal chart
 This guide does not go into deeper interpretive material
 or archetypal synthesis (such as connecting Mars with
 Aries and the 1st House)—that comes in the next stage of
 your learning journey.

READING ASTROLOGY SYMBOLS:

The Language of the Sky

Astrology is a symbolic language. Each planet, sign, and house has its own symbol—a visual shorthand that represents its energy, purpose, and influence. Learning these symbols is like learning the alphabet of a new language: it is the first step toward fluency.

Symbols are not just drawings; they carry meaning. The faster you become familiar with them, the sooner you will be able to read a chart with ease.

The Houses and Their Meanings

1st House – identity, appearance, self

2nd House – money, values, possessions

3rd House – communication, learning, siblings

4th House – home, family, roots

5th House – creativity, romance, children

6th House – work, health, routines

7th House – relationships, partnerships

8th House – shared resources, intimacy,

transformation, death

9th House – travel, philosophy, higher learning

10th House – career, public life, reputation

11th House – friends, community, goals


12th House – spirituality, hidden matters, endings



THE HOUSES IN THE WHEEL


This image shows how the houses are arranged in the astrological chart wheel.

• The 1st House begins on the left side at the horizontal center. This point is the Ascendant (AC), also called the Rising Sign.




- Directly opposite is the Descendant (DC), the starting point of the 7th House.
- At the bottom of the chart is the Nadir (IC), the beginning of the 4th House.
- At the top is the Midheaven (MC), the start of the 10th House.

These four points are called the Angles—they are among the most important points in a chart. Once you recognize them, the rest of the houses fall neatly in between and are easy to locate.

HOW TO UNDERSTAND HOUSES, SIGNS, AND PLANETS

As you become familiar with these symbols, you will start to see the story of a chart unfold at a glance.

- The Planet = the energy, the character → the "who" is speaking in the chart
- The Sign = the costume, the behavior, the agenda
 - → how the planet speaks, expresses itself, and what it ultimately wants
- The House = the arena of life → where the energy is expressed, the decor of the scene
 Visualizing the houses helps you place the energy in life.

Think of the chart like a play: the whole play is you, and each placement is a different part of you expressing through character, agenda, and stage.

Later, we will see how the planets speak to each other through aspects. For now, focus on learning the symbols and archetypes first.



PRACTICE TIP

- Visualize charts daily.
- Start with one planet at a time: name the symbol, the sign, the house, and its keywords.
- With repetition, your brain will automatically translate the symbols into meaning.


At this stage, focus only on recognizing the symbols—like learning an alphabet. The deeper meanings will come later.
