### **The Hudson Eye Stimulates Creativity, Expands Diversity, & Grows Tourism With A Multi-Venue Series**

Active in Hudson since 2006, Jonah Bokaer Arts Foundation presents **The Hudson Eye**, arranged by ascendant curatorial voice Aaron Levi Garvey. **The Hudson Eye** is an artist-driven, 10-day annual public program and urban showcase, focusing on Dance, Music, Performance, Film, Visual Art, Dining Out, Nightlife, and Hot Topics Panels highlighting issues of interest to the local community. Taking place August 25th - September 4th 2023 as a celebratory close to Hudson's peak tourism weekend of the summer, we work deeply at all levels of the city to consider what it means to be part of the Hudson community fabric, and look inward at our own relationship to the City Of Hudson over the past 16 years of programs. **The Hudson Eye** was born to be shared annually in partnership, and steers an anonymous \$50,000 Local Matching Grant to Hudson, to stimulate local giving.
