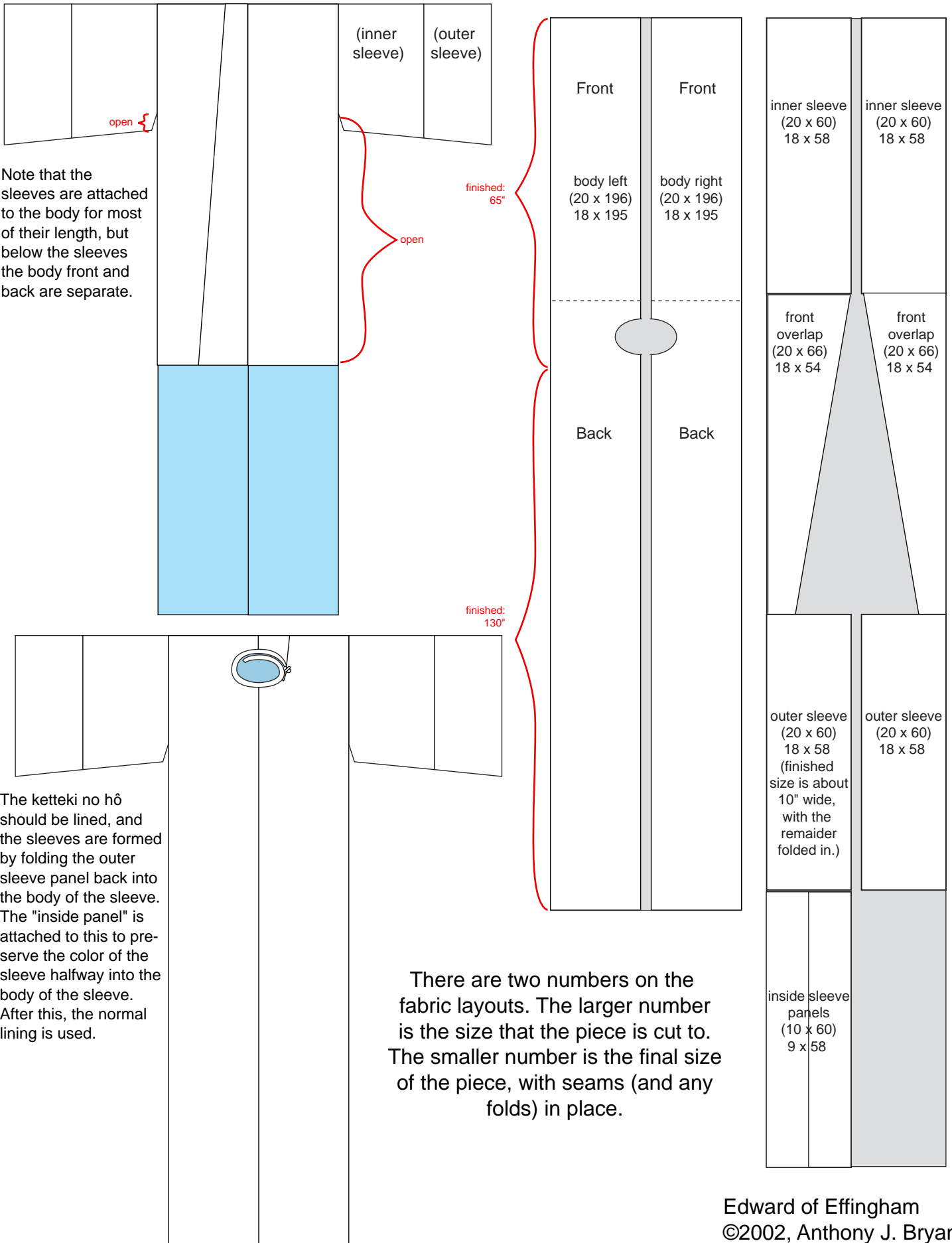


Kettekino h™



Note that the sleeves are attached to the body for most of their length, but below the sleeves the body front and back are separate.

The kettekino h should be lined, and the sleeves are formed by folding the outer sleeve panel back into the body of the sleeve. The "inside panel" is attached to this to preserve the color of the sleeve halfway into the body of the sleeve. After this, the normal lining is used.

There are two numbers on the fabric layouts. The larger number is the size that the piece is cut to. The smaller number is the final size of the piece, with seams (and any folds) in place.
