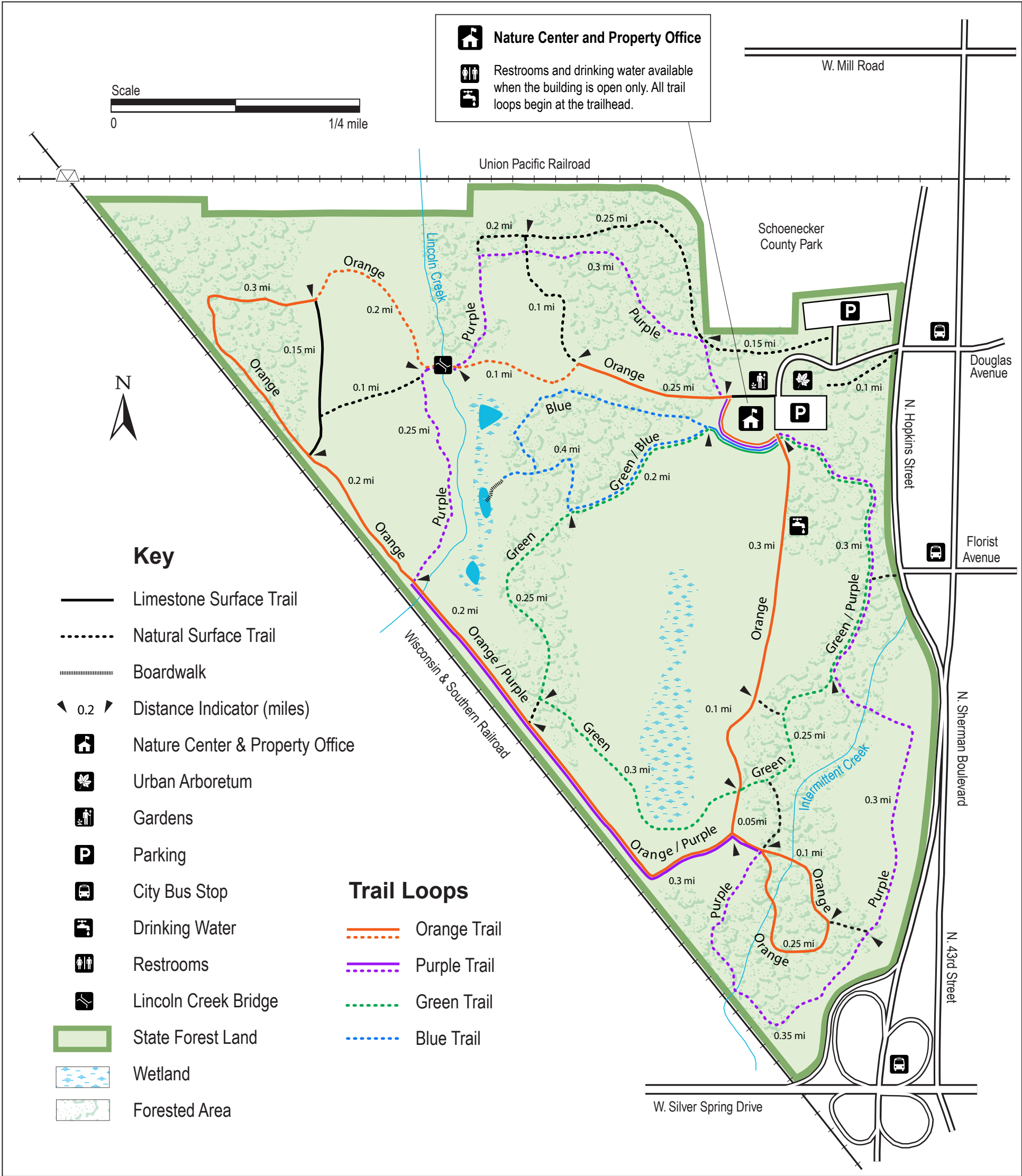


# HAVENWOODS STATE FOREST



## HAVENWOODS TRAILS

More than six miles of trails invite hikers, runners and walkers to explore the property's woods, wetlands and grasslands. Visitors can choose one of the colored loop trails or take connecting routes of varying length. Trail loops begin and end at the Nature Center trailhead.

**Orange Trail** – This trail winds along the tallgrass prairie, through the hardwood forest and over the Lincoln Creek footbridge. The trail is mostly surfaced with limestone except a 0.3-mile section which has a natural surface. The trail has little to no slope. The Orange Trail is the only trail designated for pets. 2.3 miles.

**Purple Trail** – This trail winds through tallgrass prairie, past a pond habitat, over the Lincoln Creek footbridge and through a stand of hardwoods. The trail has a limestone and natural surface with little to no slope. 2.0 miles.

**Green Trail** – This trail winds through tallgrass prairie and hardwood forest. The trail has a limestone and natural surface with little to no slope. 1.2 miles.

**Blue Trail** – This trail winds along the tallgrass prairie, through the hardwood forest and leads to a pond with a pier. The trail has a natural surface with little to no slope. 0.7 miles.
