Policy L02: Unpaid internships

Updated: August 20, 2017 **Expires**: August 20, 2020

WHEREAS internships and co-op placements have become an integral part of many postsecondary programs and a first step into the labour force, with 55% of graduating students across Canada completing a placement in 2009; and

WHEREAS there is a lack of clarity surrounding the application of New Brunswick's *Employment Standards Acts* with regard to interns; and

WHEREAS the average debt of New Brunswick postsecondary students graduating with debt is \$35,200;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the New Brunswick Student Alliance advocate that the provincial government amend the New Brunswick *Employment Standards Act* to clarify that interns require compensation including, but not limited to, academic credit or remuneration equivalent to, at minimum, the provincial minimum wage; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the New Brunswick Student Alliance advocate that the provincial government enforce provincial labour laws to ensure fair treatment and compensation of interns.
