Policy F04: Removal of Credit Checks from Grant Applications

Updated: November 25, 2018 **Expires**: November 25, 2020

WHEREAS the primary purpose of the Free Tuition Program (FTP) and Tuition Relief for the Middle Class (TMRC) is to increase access for low and middle income students to a publicly-funded postsecondary institution;

WHEREAS accessibility of postsecondary education is a fundamental organizational value of the Alliance:

WHEREAS credit scores reflect a person's ability to use credit responsibility which is directly influenced by their access to education, economic opportunity, and financial support, among others;

WHEREAS individuals from low income families, young people, and minorities statistically have lower credit scores:

WHEREAS the Government of New Brunswick has provided no reasoning for requiring credit checks on students applying for up-front, needs-based grants; and

WHEREAS requiring credit checks on students applying for grants further marginalizes students that require these programs the most.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the New Brunswick Student Alliance advocate that the Government of New Brunswick remove credit checks from grant applications.
