



ROW SHAWL

Pattern Written by Nancy Rieck

MEASUREMENTS

18 inches long, 32 inches at neck area

MATERIALS

440 yards, Feza Yarns, Alp Dazzle (4 skeins)
Size needles 8 U.S./5 mm

Notions Required: tapestry needle.

GAUGE

16 sts x 20 Rows = 4 inches in garter stitch on size Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

W/T: (Wrap and Turn) Place yarn on opposite side of work, Slip next st as if to purl. Bring yarn to original side of work and slip st back to left needle. Turn work, return yarn to wrong side and work back. (When you come to a wrap on the following row, make it less visible by knitting the wrap together with the stitch it wraps.) Repeat patterns in between **



PATTERN

CO 76 sts.

Row 1(RS): K76. **Row 2(WS):** P76. **Row 3(RS):** K38, W/T. **Row 4(WS):** P38.

*Repeat rows 1 and 2 10 times for a total of 20 rows worked. Repeat rows 3 and 4. *

Work this sequence until piece measures 32 inches at shortest edge. End with working rows 1 and 2 once after a row 4.

BO all sts and secure yarn.

FINISHING

With tapestry needle weave in all loose ends. Block to size.
