68 How to Pronounce "ENT" at the End of ...

HOW TO PRONOUNCE "ENT" AT THE END OF WORDS:

- [ã] at the end of words when the word is either a noun, an adjective, or an adverb.
- silent at the end of a conjugated verb, in the 3rd person of the plural. (after "ils" or "elles")

## EXAMPLES

- Il y a du v<u>ent</u>. (It's windy.)
- Il est très l<u>ent</u>. (He's very slow.)
- Évidemment! (Obviously!)
- Ils mangent des fruits. (They're eating fruits.) -> SILENT
- Elles parlent français. (They speak French.) -> SILENT
