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Class Descriptions

Actor's Playground - Through use of theatre games, improvisation, and story dramatization, students will be able to explore the world of acting and theatre. Students will build a foundation of acting techniques and tools to develop characters and create stories, all while sharpening their creativity and improving their self-confidence, as they learn the importance of teamwork and ensemble building.

Adult Musical Theatre: Lin Manuel Miranda- Join us Monday nights in this popular class as we take a look at the work of songwriter, actor, singer, filmmaker, and playwright, Lin Manuel Miranda. Our adult actors will get the chance to sing hit songs from some of Miranda's most popular works such as Hamilton, In the Heights, Encanto and more!

ASL for Theatre- Hundreds of different types of communication are used all around the world, including American Sign Language (ASL). Almost half a million individuals in the United States rely on it daily. In ASL for Theatre, students will learn the basics needed for communication, play sign based theatre games, and learn the skills needed to help provide ASL access for theatrical performances. Join us in this brand new class as we work to help make theater more accessible for all!

Bluey and Bingo's Big Adventure- Mom! Dad! Bingo! BLUEY!!! Bingo and Bluey are back for their next big adventure! Students will use their bodies, voices, and imagination to explore the world of Bluey and friends. Through movement, games, team building, and silly scenes, students will use the tools of an actor to make friends and have fun!

Costuming and Sewing Cohort - Explore the world of costume design and construction in this hands-on class.

Dino-Drama- Dance, move and play like dinosaurs in this Jurassic adventure! This fun and engaging class invites your preschooler to experience an exciting journey through a prehistoric world of movement, creative play and story-telling. Must be potty-trained.

Dory and Friends- The Young Musical Theatre showcase is developed specifically for actors ages 5-7 who are interested in learning the process of putting on a musical. This class curriculum focuses on teaching students the basics of acting, building self-confidence, and working together through creative collaboration.

Fantasy Family On Broadway- Do you want to become a part of the Fantasy Family? Join us for an exciting new class that gets families and friends singing and dancing together! Caregivers participate alongside their students, learning beginning level musical theatre jazz dance and songs from hit Broadway shows. Come experience the world of Broadway and make Magic together with the whole family! *An adult must register for this class with their child*

Fantasy Show Choir- It's time for actors to sing and dance their way to the top! In this Show Choir competition-style class, students will rehearse and present a showcase of songs from movies, musicals, and more! This class is designed to enhance students' knowledge of dance technique, music theory, harmony work, and building ensemble. We recommend taking this class more than once!

Disney's Finding Nemo Jr.- Join us for FPCTA's production of Disney's Finding Nemo Jr.! This exciting musical is an adaptation of the beloved 2003 Pixar movie Finding Nemo, with new music by award-winning songwriting team Kristen Anderson-Lopez and Robert Lopez (Frozen). Marlin, an anxious and over-protective clownfish, lives in the Great Barrier Reef with his kid Nemo, who longs to explore the world beyond their anemone home. But when Nemo is captured and taken to Sydney, Marlin faces his fears and sets off on an epic adventure across the ocean. With the help of lovable characters such as optimistic Dory, laid-back sea turtle Crush, and the supportive Tank Gang, Marlin and Nemo both overcome challenges on their journey to find each other and themselves. Featuring memorable songs such as "Just Keep Swimming," "Fish Are Friends Not Food," and "Go With the Flow," Finding Nemo Jr. brings a vibrant underwater world to life on stage in a story full of family, friendship, and adventure!

Homeschool: Acting & Improv- Looking for a way to work out your funny bone? Then this is the class for you! Through acting technique, improv games, and sketches, actors will learn to develop original characters and stories while striking comedy gold! Don't miss the laughs and a chance to find your inner comedian. This class is designed to be taken more than once!

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Homeschool: Musical Theatre- Do you love to sing and dance? This class is the perfect fit for you! Our homeschool actors will work on improving their vocal technique while learning musical theatre dance choreography. Actors in this class will learn selections of scenes and songs from hit Broadway shows. Classes will focus on improving acting technique and introducing beginning music theory, musical theatre terminology, and choreography.

Just Keep Swimming- Join our friends Nemo, Marlin and Dory under the sea in this music, movement and theatre class! Your preschooler will explore the deep blue sea using characterization, songs and creative movement. Must be potty-trained.

Lab 87: An Actor's Conservatory- This pre-professional training program is intended for serious performers ages 13-18. Students will be exposed to a variety of performance skills including on-camera acting, resume building, musical theatre, audition technique, voice & movement, and classical text work. Students will also have the opportunity to meet with college programs and area professionals in the performing arts field. Each student will leave the class with their own customized audition book of material and updated resume. The goal of Lab 87 is for our students to graduate the program with the necessary skills to work and train professionally as a performing artist.

Admission is by audition only in August of each year. Previous members are automatically enrolled in the upcoming program.

Magic Maker's Fall Puppetry Cohort: The Jungle Book- This season we invite all crafty, creative theatre students 12 and up to join our new Puppetry Cohort, led by 63rd Season resident magic Maker Ethan Mitchel. Learn the ins and out of building larger than life puppets- tigers, snakes, elephants, and all the wild life characters of the new mainstage production of The Jungle Book presented at the VBC Playhouse in October. Students will be invited to join the backstage production team helping to design, build, and care for these homemade creatures of the jungle!

Magic Suitcase- Have you ever wanted to be a part of the magic at Fantasy Playhouse? Join us this semester as we check out what exciting adventures await our beginning actors in this brand new class! Through imagination, songs, and creative play, our young actors will work together to act out or even create their own stories and characters as their Magic Suitcase takes them to a new destination each week. Pack your suitcase and come along as we "Let the Magic Begin!"

Move & Play!- Get ready to move and play! Through use of music, games and movement, your preschooler will work on building skills like teamwork, active listening, and creative expression. Must be potty-trained.

Music with Me- A music, singing and sensory class for families! You and your little one will sing, play and dance together. Class activities include storytelling, creative movement, as well as work with scarves, instruments, and various other props.

Musical Theatre Dance: Newsies- Now is the time to seize the day! Feel like the King of New York in this high-energy musical theatre dance class. Dancers will work on improving their technique while learning musical theatre dance choreography. Each week students will learn short combinations to the musical numbers of Disney's hit Broadway show and movie musical, Newsies!

Musical Theatre I- Has your actor been bit by the Broadway bug? In this beginning musical theatre class, actors will focus on learning different elements of musical theatre like how to use their body, voice, and imagination to tell a story through song and dance. Students will also work on applying the tools of an actor to different scenes and exercises while making friends and building confidence along the way.

Musical Theatre II- Singing, dancing, and acting are a few of our favorite things in this intermediate musical theatre class. Join us as we work on the fundamental methods of musical theatre and learn to incorporate character choices and stage movement within the story of the song. Actors will enhance their knowledge of music theory, dance technique, and musical theatre terminology. We recommend taking this class more than once.

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On Camera Acting- Have you ever wondered what it was like to audition for film, tv and commercials? This is a perfect introduction into the world of On Camera Acting! The course will work on the most important skills for an on camera performance, including taking direction, finding your mark, on-camera acting techniques, and cold readings all while having fun performing film, tv and commercial scripts. Students will leave class having learned to analyze scripts and master the techniques needed to record themselves for successful self-submissions.

Playmakers Lab- In this class, YOU are the writer and theatre-maker. Co-lead by Artistic Director, Stephen Tyler Davis, Education Director, Taylor Bogan and Associate Education Director, Kailey Burkhardt, students will be taken through a variety of creative activities. Through use of writing prompts, theatre games, performance exercises, and collaboration, students will create and devise an original performance piece. This is the perfect class for any young writer, actor, or storyteller.

Sing Disney! Dance Disney!- Back by popular demand! This class will leave actors singing and dancing all week long! Join us for this exciting class as we focus on learning the basics of musical theatre while reenacting songs and scenes from your favorite Disney favorites. Actors will also work on creative movement, rhythm, and critical thinking through warm-ups, games, and improv.

Technical Theatre Cohort- Our Technical Theatre cohort will experience a variety of technical roles within the theatre. Students will learn the basics of set design and construction, technical theatre safety, scenic painting, as well as light and sound design. Training continues backstage where students will learn what it takes to work on a show by participating as technical crew for our showcase performances.

Teen Showcase: Curious Incident of the Dog in the Nighttime- 15-year-old Christopher has an extraordinary brain: He is exceptional at mathematics but ill-equipped to interpret everyday life. He has never ventured alone beyond the end of his road, he detests being touched, and he distrusts strangers. Now it is 7 minutes after midnight, and Christopher stands beside his neighbor's dead dog, Wellington. Finding himself under suspicion, Christopher is determined to solve the mystery of who murdered Wellington, and he carefully records each fact of the crime. But his detective work, forbidden by his father, takes him on a thrilling journey that upturns his world. The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time is a play by Simon Stephens based on the novel of the same name by Mark Haddon. During its premiere run, the play tied the record for winning the most Olivier Awards (seven), including Best New Play at the 2013 ceremony.

Theatrical Makeup Cohort- Learn techniques of age, natural, and fantasy makeup to transform the actor.

Young Actor's Workshop- Calling all actors! In this intermediate class, students will continue to build on acting techniques through script work, theatre games, scene study, monologues, and character development. This is the perfect class for learning stage directions, reading and memorizing dialogue, and creating character through voice and physicality.
