Dear Rob Hosack:

On March 23, 2020, you notified the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) that Cobb County had authorized Sterigenics, a commercial sterilizer of medical equipment located in Cobb County at 2971 Olympic Industrial Drive, Atlanta, to conduct the negative pressure system testing required by EPD in an October 9, 2019, letter to Sterigenics. The negative pressure system is designed to capture the indoor air at the Sterigenics facility and route it through newly installed air pollution control equipment for the purpose of capturing fugitive ethylene oxide emissions.

On March 24, 2020, the negative pressure system was tested by a third party test team. EPD had staff from the Industrial Source Monitoring Unit onsite to audit the testing. The testing was conducted without the use of any ethylene oxide. Based on the preliminary information gathered during the test audit, the system appeared to be working as designed. The negative pressure testing was done in accordance with the Protocol for Permanent Total Enclosure Testing submitted to EPD on October 31, 2019. EPD will review the final test report when it is submitted as required by Condition 6.1 of Georgia Air Quality Permit No. 7389-067-0093-S-05-0, as amended.
