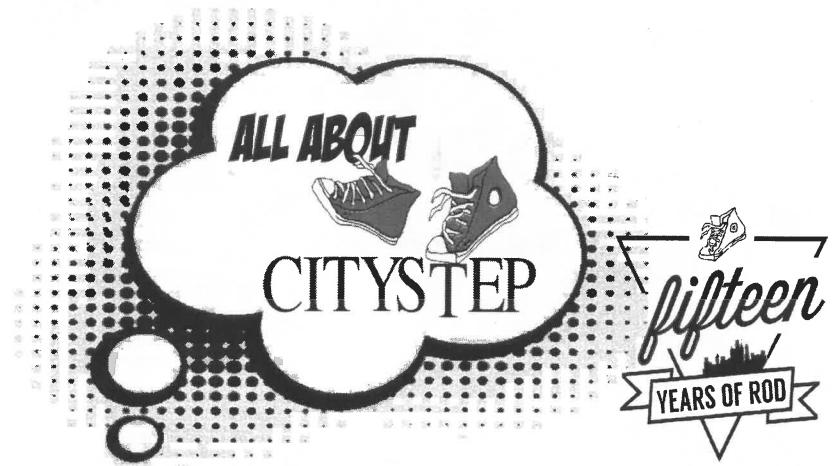

CITYSTEP WAS FOUNDED OVER THIRTY YEARS AGO AND WAS STARTED AT HARVARD UNIVERSITY BY SABRINA PECK ('84), WHO WANTED TO HELP YOUNG STUDENTS EXPERIENCE FOR THEMSELVES THE POWER OF DANCE TO EXPRESS EMOTIONS AND IDEAS. IN 2004, LAURA WEIDMAN ('04), A VETERAN OF THE HARVARD PROGRAM, TEAMED UP WITH TWO PENN UNDERGRADUATES, ALICIA MARINI ('06) AND MARTHA MIJES ('06), TO ESTABLISH CITYSTEP PENN.

15 YEARS LATER, CITYSTEP CONTINUES TO THRIVE AND GROW AT PENN. CITYSTEP IS GRATEFUL TO PARTNER WITH FOUR INCREDIBLE SCHOOLS IN SOUTH AND WEST PHILLY AND TO HAVE OVER 150 PASSIONATE STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN TWICE WEEKLY PROGRAMMING.

## TEACHER TRAINING AT THE NATIONAL DANCE INSTITUTE

THIS PAST SEPTEMBER, THE COMPANY HAD THE HONOR OF TRAVELING TO NEW YORK CITY TO MEET UP WITH CITYSTEP YALE AND CITYSTEP HARVARD'S LEADERSHIP TEAMS FOR WEEKEND-LONG RETREAT AT THE NATIONAL DANCE INSTITUTE (NDI) IN HARLEM. THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND WE ENGAGED IN ACTIVITIES AND WORKSHOPS LED BY NDI AS WELL AS OUR HEROINE FOUNDER, SABRINA PECK AND CITYSTEP PENN'S VERY OWN MATTHEW DUDA (2014-2015 CO-EVENTS CHAIR).

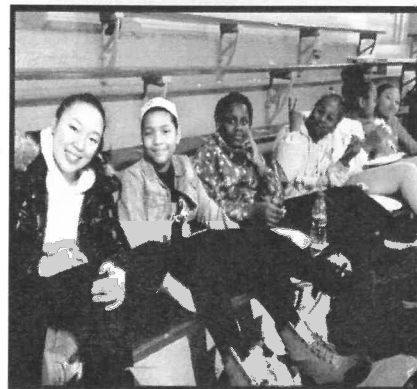
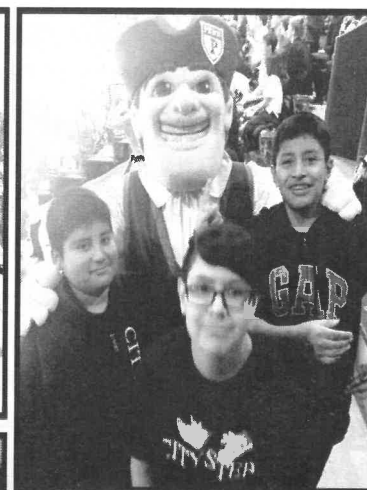


## FALL DANCESHOP
