# SEASONS, COURT AVAILABILITY & PEAK TIMES

Daily court availability is 6:30AM to 10:00PM 7 days per week, courts are booked in 1.5 hour slots.

## TENNIS COURT USER CLASSIFICATION

- Resident Owner or renter who is registered with Access Management (HOA) to make court reservations.
- Visitor someone visiting and staying overnight in a resident's home.
- Guest someone not living in this (ICP) community, not a resident.

## **COURT RESERVATION RULES**

Social play, Ball machine & Tennis instruction

Our online court reservation system is available at

https://islesofcollierpreserve.org/play (prior registration with the HOA is required)

- Resident may book 1 court per day for social play (Singles or doubles), ball machine
  usage or tennis instruction (private coaching/tennis instruction) subject to the rules &
  restrictions defined below.
- Visitor/Guest has no rights to make reservations. Play is allowed via invitation from Resident.
- Certified tennis instructors (pre-approved by HOA) may be invited to ICP and added to a reservation as a guest.
- Court bookings are restricted to no more than 2 weeks in advance.
- Court reservations must name the individuals playing (including the tennis instructor where appropriate).
- Residents are expected to cancel reservations prior to the scheduled time of play if they do not intend to use the court.
- A reservation will be held for ten (10) minutes after scheduled start time. Thereafter, the court can be re-assigned, or used by a walk-on resident.
- Open courts which become available either as a walk-on or no reservation made can be used by any Resident for any usage including practice or ball machine.
- Approved Team Play will be booked in advance by Access Management (HOA) for warm up and match play.

#### **Reservation Restrictions**

- Court bookings are restricted to know more than 2 weeks in advance.
- Individuals may not reserve court for 1 player usage (e.g., ball machine or serve practicing) inside the peak time for the relevant season.
- A resident can have not more than 3 guests in a reservation.
- A reservation will be forfeited if the players are more than 10 minutes late.

## DRESS CODE, FOOTWEAR AND BEHAVIOR

- Appropriate tennis attire is required. Beach clothing, cutoffs, sports bras, bathing suits and men's tank tops are not permitted.
- Shirts must be worn.
- Only smooth bottom (clay-court) tennis shoes are allowed on the courts. Running shoes, sandals, hiking shoes, etc. is not permitted.

#### COURT ETIQUETTE

- Refrain from excessive, loud or abusive conversation including profanity.
- Smoking on the court is not permitted.
- Food and gum are not permitted on the courts. Drinks must be in a non-breakable spillproof container.
- Do not play past your time if others are waiting. If additional time is needed, look for an available court to finish you match.
- Tennis operations may be suspended by the management company or designee (court maintenance personnel) due to inclement weather or otherwise as determined.

#### **COURT GROOMING**

We have two Aussie Mats that are available to groom a court when required.

PLEASE NOTE: Wet courts are not to be groomed (brushed or raked). Grooming courts while wet will cause damage to the courts, and an unnecessary expense for repairs.

Please report any other court issues or damage please inform the Tennis committee as soon as possible.

#### **CHILDREN**

Parents or other supervisory adults will be responsible for their children's behavior at all times on the courts and will be responsible for any damages they may cause. Children under 15 years of age must always be accompanied by an adult unless participating in an organized program or tennis instruction.

## **TENNIS LIGHT USAGE**

If lights are not on a timer, please turn off as you leave the court.

#### **TENNIS MIXER**

Tennis mixers may be arranged by the tennis committee or residents. A tennis mixer should conform to normal court reservation rules where residents need to make appropriate court reservations. Tennis mixers allow for residents and their visitors to sign-up, outside guests are not permitted.

Tennis mixers will be publicized on the ICP social media platform groups (Facebook, TeamReach).

## **DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

Residents should report any rule infractions directly to the tennis committee.

A resident who has multiple warnings due to infractions may be suspended from making court reservations for a period of time.

## TEAM PLAY (USTA & CTA)

Teams wishing to play at the Isles must submit a roster to the committee and to the Access Management office, including players names, day of play, name of Captain, and team competition level...for example USTA 3.5, CTA 3.5, etc..

Courts will be assigned for League play by Access Management when the above information is received and approved by the Tennis Committee and Access Management.

Team captains will open team enrollment to all ICP residents in respect to level of-team play. If residents at the appropriate level (as assessed by the captain) cannot reasonably complete a team roster, the team captain will submit a note to the committee for approval to admit a non-ICP player(s) to the team.

NOTE: The Tennis Committee and Access Management has the right to accept or decline a team if it does not meet the requirements as stated above or does not follow the rules throughout its season.

Team play should not occur inside Peak time for the active Season.

It is the responsibility of each team captain to coordinate any scheduling conflicts between two teams playing on the same day by contacting the league team leader to schedule matches of each team on alternating weeks.

The Team captain must register visiting teams with gate security to allow access to the Isles Tennis Facility.
