Safety Coffin

A safety coffin or security coffin contains a mechanism to prevent premature burial, allowing the person a way to call out if they have been buried alive. A large number of designs for safety coffins were patented during the 18th and 19th centuries and variations on the idea are still available today.

Catacombs

Catacombs are huge, highly decorated underground cemeteries that contain many bodies. Some are like whole cities of tombs underneath the ground where the living dwelled.

Grave Goods

Grave goods are items that are buried with the deceased that may benefit them in the afterlife. In East Asia this practice strongly resembles that of the Hell Bank Note, which is burnt as an offering to ancestor spirits.

Mourning Jewellery

Mourning jewellery is of two general types, either a commemorative piece which marks the death of an individual, or one which denotes that the wearer is observing a period of formal bereavement. Some of these items contained the person's hair intricately braided or even occasionally a small tooth.

Spirit Photography

Spirit Photography is a type of photography that tries to capture images of ghosts and other spiritual entities, especially in ghost hunting. It has a strong history dating back to the late 19th century.

Memento Mori Photography

Memento Mori Photography is the Victorian practice of taking pictures of dead family members to preserve their memory. The deceased were often posed to look alive.

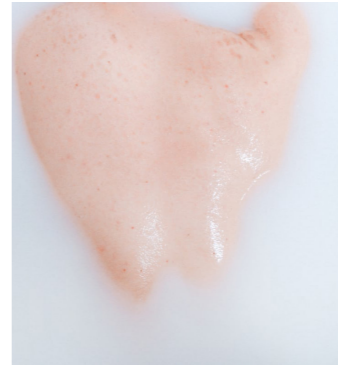

Eternal Reef

Reef balls combine a cremation urn, ash scattering, and burial at sea. Ashes are mixed with concrete and molded into a reef ball – a hollow, holey structure that sits on the seafloor, ideally creating marine habitat and preventing erosion that can be visited by scuba diving.

Transform Hair or Ashes into Diamonds

Using your ashes or hair the carbon is extracted to create laboratory grown diamonds that can be made into jewellery.

Memorial Tattoo with Cremation Ashes

Combines a small portion of cremated remains with traditional tattoo ink and allows you to then use the ink for tattooing purposes.

Mushroom Suit

Is a burial method that reduces toxins in the body by being buried in a cotton bodysuit covered in mushroom spores that facilitate decomposition.

Natural Burial

A natural burial describes a burial area that creates habitat for wildlife or preserves existing natural spaces. It includes funeral processes that have a low environmental impact, prohibiting embalming and, where a coffin is used, choosing natural, biodegradable materials e.g. willow coffins or leaf shrouds.

Woodland Burial

A woodland Burial (green burial or natural burial) is an eco-friendly funeral option. Woodland burials are an environmentally-friendly alternative to traditional burials and cremation that take place in natural burial grounds, or designated woodland burial sites in larger cemeteries.

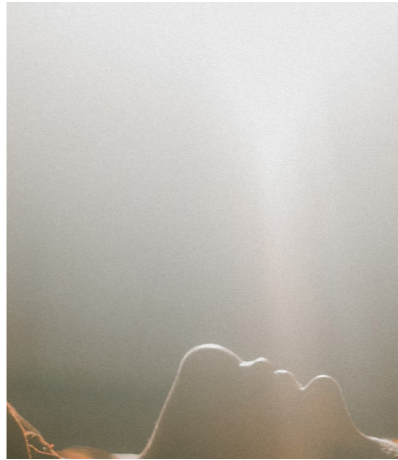
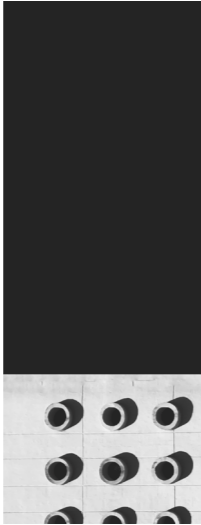

**Water Burial /
Green Cremation
(alkaline hydrolysis)**

Green cremation involves the placement of the body inside a tank with water and lye, the process is more eco friendly than traditional cremation. Eventually, bone is the only solid left and the ashes received at the end of this process are white and powdery.

Cardboard Coffins

Cardboard coffins are an eco-friendly option that can be drawn on or decorated with photographs and memories.

**Streaming and
Livecasting Funerals**

Funerals can be streamed or livecast in real-time via webcam for relatives in other countries who have been unable to attend in person.

Virtual Wakes

Brazilian wakes (“velórios” in Portuguese) are a combination of memorial and funeral service, with the (usually unembalmed) body placed inside a coffin on display for mourners to gather around. Virtual wakes can be watched by relatives or friends of the deceased who could not attend the vigil in person.

**QR Codes
on Gravestones**

By placing a QR code onto the grave, either carved into the headstone or using an adhesive sticker you can leave and access digital content like photos, video or text, scanning the barcode and viewing it via a mobile phone.

Robot Funerals

Funeral conducted by Robots like Pepper the Robot, or for robots like AIBO dogs when they have finished their service. Most robot funerals have been conducted in Japan.

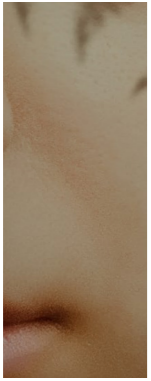

Using Community Funeral Services

A Community Funeral Service (CFS) is a community-owned enterprise which has a common purpose. It allows volunteers and professionals to be members, supporting the creation of funerals that share three common objectives: commercial, social and environmental.

Profile Memorialization & Legacy Contacts

Some social media services (including Facebook and Instagram) have services that allow you to delete, deactivate or memorialize a person's profile, where the profile remains active as a memorial. Some services also give options to set up a Legacy Contact. A legacy contact is a person who will take responsibility for your memorialised social media profile after you die.

Space Burial

A space burial is where some element of the body, most often ashes or hair in a small container, is flown into space. Space Burials may orbit around the Earth or be sent to extra-terrestrial bodies such as the Moon, or further into space.

Employ a Digital Auditor or Curator

A digital auditor is a person who is paid to go through the online collections of a person after death and sort them out for the next of kin. A digital curator may additionally develop collections that identify favourite content and/or cleaning and removing private content. They may also create artefacts such as photo books or films for the family. Very few services of this kind currently exist.

Funerals in Gaming Environments

When active members of gaming communities die, fellow players or clan members can use the specific environments of a gaming universe to create bespoke memorials or funerary activities e.g. putting their avatars into prayer position or constructing visual signifiers like RIP in the digital space.

Pre-recorded Information, Instructions of Messages Online

Various online companies offer services that give people the opportunity to pre-record messages for loved ones after death, including a date or a significant event (for example before a wedding) in which to play the message.

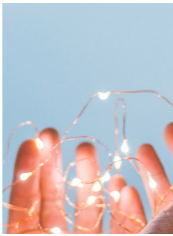

Online Vigils

When someone dies, a watch is kept over the body until the burial service. Prayers are said and candles lit. Vigils extend from eventual death to burial but may also be added to through online prayers or lighting of virtual candles.

Lifelogging

Lifelogging is when someone wears a camera or other recording device that takes pictures or film/ audio constantly to be kept as a record of their life.

Cremation Energy
(for personal or social use)

When bodies are cremated they produce energy. By installing turbines in crematoriums this energy can be used to generate electricity. Some crematoriums and artistic project have explored what could be done with this energy such as producing a set of batteries for the family or donating this energy to a social cause.

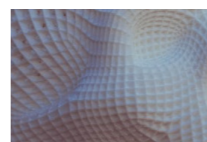

Human Composting

Human Composting is a natural organic reduction that creates an accelerated decomposition method, transforming human remains into soil over a period of four to seven weeks. It is in the early stages of policy law in the USA.

3D Printing Ashes

3D printers use a sediment material that can be printed with layers of glue to create any desired form. This sediment can be replaced with ashes to create a bespoke and appropriate memorial object.

DNA spliced with a Tree

This is a ritual where a scientist would replace unused, or "junk", DNA in a tree's chromosomes with parts of a human donor's to create a hybrid where the human genes are present in every cell of the plant.

Deletion Rituals

A deletion ritual is when all or specific parts of a person's digital identity are deleted. This can be done using USB sticks that are then liquefied in acid or embalmed in plastic. Or through a technical tool/algorithm/virus that goes through all your accounts systematically deleting them.

Rememory

A rememory may be a product of lifelogging, in which the complete record of their life is edited and used as a cinematic experience from the point of view of the deceased.

Digital Memory Object

A digital memory object is a person's digital life contained within a physical object for future generations. This could be a digital interface cased in a box on a shelf, a shared shrine in the garden or a piece of digital jewellery.

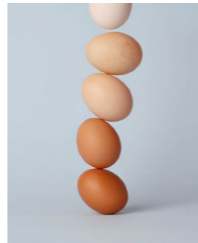
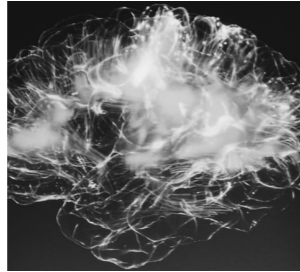

Future remembrance events may include immersive experiences of a person's memories. These memories could be shown to audiences through virtual and/ or augmented reality.

Anniversary Hologram

Technical Reanimation is the idea that someone can be brought back to life using their words and collections online to reconstruct thought patterns, creating a new digital entity or avatar.

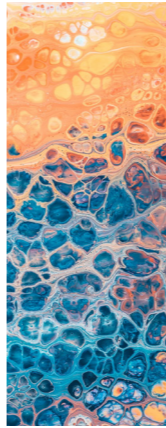
