- All allocated spaces will be outdoors. We cannot guarantee that this allocated space will be covered.
- Only the space allocated by DCUSU may be used.
- Promotional teams may not exceed five people.
- Collection of personal information must be approved in advance with DCU Students' Union and must comply with GDPR regulations. Pen and paper cannot be used for gathering data from students.
- All Covid-19, Health and Safety and social distancing guidelines must be adhered to.
- A queuing system should be put in place if congestion arises.
- Companies must complete their own setup.
- The University's Parking Policy must be adhered to.



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
