# Jump Start Lite 2020

## When will Jump Start Lite be held?

Jump Start Lite will meet for a total of 10 days after school in May and June of 2020. We will have Jump Start Lite on **May 18, 19, 21, 27, 28, 29; June 1, 2, 3 and 4th**. Transportation will be provided from your child's elementary school (following dismissal at 3:15) to William Annin Middle School.

*Transportation is ONLY provided from Mount Prospect, Liberty Corner, Oak Street and Cedar Hill. All students will need to be picked up by parents at William Annin Middle School at 6 pm sharp.*

## What do students do at Jump Start Lite?

Students enrolled in Jump Start Lite will still get all of the same classes that are offered during the summer Camp Jump Start program, which includes Study skills, Math, English, Tech ed, as well as 3 "cycles" of Art, Team building, and a World language. During Jump Start Lite, on a daily basis, students will meet with the Study Skills teachers and learn a variety of lessons that focus on middle school success. Included in the schedule, students will have Math, English and Tech ed classes on a rotating basis, as well as Art, Team building, and a World language. All students will also get their own locker to use while at Jump Start Lite, and will have an opportunity to interact with students from our other elementary schools. ***Due to our after school schedule, we will not be taking any field trips during Jump Start Lite.***

## How much will Jump Start Lite cost?

Jump Start Lite will cost **\$350.00** for the 10 day session. The cost of the program includes transportation to William Annin Middle School for the 10 days, student supplies (binder, dividers, etc), and exciting classes taught by certified middle school teachers.

### **What will the afternoon look like at Jump Start Lite?**

Students will be picked up by bus at their elementary schools and brought to William Annin Middle School. At Annin, students will have a snack (which they will bring from home). After snack, the students will then go through a schedule which will include study skills (daily), in addition to a rotation of Math, English, Tech ed, as well as 3 “cycles” of Art, Team building, and a World Language. All students will receive a schedule on the first day of the program.

### **How and when can I register my child for Jump Start Lite?**

Registration can be done online only at <http://www.bernardsboe.com/parents/payments/> and following these steps:

1. On the payments page, under DISTRICT WIDE, click where it says to “Please click here to make online payments.”
2. Once you are on that page to make the online payment, scroll down to the section that says *Make a Payment* and click on “Jump Start Lite.” Complete the form and payment as directed.

**Registration will open on Monday, December 9th and will close on Friday, February 28<sup>th</sup>. No late registrations will be accepted and payment is nonrefundable.**

### **Is there a limit on the number of students you are accepting?**

We must have at least 70 students enrolled to run the program. If we do not meet our minimum, an email will be sent to those who enrolled to notify them that the program will not run and the payment will be refunded.

**Due to room constraints in the building, we have a maximum number of 180 students that we will accept for the program. Registration will close at either 180 students, or February 28th, whichever comes first.** Please note, but once the registration deadline has passed, we will not accept any late registrations.
