We step into the shoes of some of the greatest characters ever created: Cio-Cio San (*Madama Butterfly*) and the eponymous Carmen. These productions also feature women behind the scenes! We co-created and co-cast these shows with Kentucky Opera and Virginia Opera, both led by women General Director/CEOs. Enjoy the familiar faces of Kathryn Henry (19/20 Baumgartner Studio Artist) in *Carmen*, and new Baumgartner Studio Artist Sara LeMesh as Galatea, the title role in *Acis and Galatea*. Resident Artistic Consultant Jill Anna Ponasik will create the world of Donizetti's *Viva la Mamma* in a new theater for us — the Pitman Theater at Alverno. Additionally, Music Director Francesco Milioto will conduct three of our four mainstage productions!

The Acts of Rebellion referenced as our season theme play out in all of these shows. Butterfly is determined to win a life in the West for her son, even if she can't be part of it. Her best friend and traditional community find this choice unfathomable, but she is committed to this path. Carmen rebels against the severely restrictive norms in Catholic Spain. As she chooses to follow her heart no matter the consequences, her decision to live free from social norms pales in comparison to the destruction caused by loving who she will. Galatea watches men battle for her, destroying her happiness, only to rediscover her divinity and resolve her own grief. And in *Viva la Mamma*, everyone is rebelling against each other in this hilarious show within a show! As wild as these diva battles become, the ultimate stage mom Mamma Agata saves the day. Don't miss the sly prologue, Cimarosa's jewel *Il maestro di capella*. Mamma Agata may steal a moment of the show before the show even begins.

As we plumb the depths of some of the most profound and the most interesting stories in the repertoire, we look forward to thrilling you with Baroque to Romantic treasures. We will laugh, cry, and celebrate this grand art form at its best.




