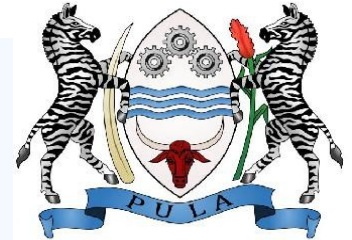


# Botswana Open for Business
