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THE LOOM

While weaving might be one of the world's oldest crafts, there's a host of fresh faces bringing a buzz back to the loom and Majeda Clarke, a one-time winner of the Cockpit Arts/The Clothworkers' Foundation award, is a name to know. Making her business viable for the modern age, she uses a loom with a computer that stores patterns in its memory to make lifting the shafts easier, while imperfections in hand-woven fabric and an aesthetic inspired by her Bengali-British heritage (think Indian motifs meeting patterns that pay homage to the modernist movement) bring a unique quality to her textiles.
