**Description:** A Orange County Salvation Army Program, which serves men experiencing homelessness.

**They DO Accept:** Mens clothing, mens gently used and new shoes, perishable and non-perishable food items, hygiene items and books

**They DO NOT Accept:** Children's toys and clothing for women

**Holiday Hours:** Open on all major holidays for donations and volunteers



**Partnering Local Organization:** Mercy House Family Assistance Shelter and Bridges on Kreamer Place.

**Description:** A 24-hour emergency shelter that provides services to adult men and women, mothers and their children, persons living with HIV/AIDS, individuals overcoming substance addiction, and those who are physically or mentally disabled.

**They DO Accept:** Hygiene items, household items, new undergarments, business casual clothing, beds, refridgerators, bus passes, food (sack lunches or catered)

**They DO NOT Accept:** aerosol sprays, glass containers, hand sanitizer, and food not prepared by a food Handler Certified group

**Description:** Provides basic needs and services to low-income residents of Orange County.

**They DO Accept:** Frozen food, uncooked food, toys, child seats, walkers, hygiene products, bikes, clothing, utensils, plastic wear

**They DO NOT Accept:** Hot meals unless approves ahead of time with kitchen staff

**Holiday Hours:** Open on all major holidays from 8am-3pm. Please call ahead to schedule a donation.



**Partnering Local Organization:** Midnight Mission of Orange County

**Description:** A homeless shelter for adults over the age of 18

**They DO Accept:** Hygiene items in bulk (shampoo, conditioner, body soap, combs, baby wipes, razors, shaving cream and feminine hygiene products)

**They DO NOT Accept:** Children's toys or clothing, perishable food items, unscheduled food drop-offs, items for distribution directly to clients,

**Holiday Hours:** Open 7-days a week, including holidays and available to receive donation drop-offs between 7:30 AM - 6:30 PM. Schedule your donation drop-off in advance, email [Courtyard@citynet.org](mailto:Courtyard@citynet.org)

**Holiday Hours:** Open on all major holidays from 9am-5pm. Please call ahead to schedule a donation.

**They DO NOT Accept:** Furniture.

**They DO NOT Accept:** Furniture.
