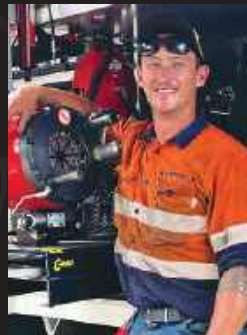

Walter's Artisan Bread

Conveniently located in the heart of Nambour, family owned Walter's Artisan Bread has a mouthwatering range of real bread and beautiful pastries, all lovingly handcrafted using world class quality ingredients and traditional baking methods.

"We bake certified organic sourdough, handcrafted from 100% Organic Australian flour, water, salt, and our famous mother culture — 'Mum'. It's bread with soul: long-fermented and naturally leavened," said bakery owner, David Mares.

Sourdough is a type of bread that is leavened through naturally occurring wild yeast and lactic acid bacteria.

The fermentation process not only

enhances its taste but also improves its digestibility and shelf life, making it healthier for the gut and a popular choice among artisan bakers and home enthusiasts alike.

The simple, natural ingredients create the perfect conditions for bread-making through slow fermentation.

The naturally occurring wild yeast and lactic acid bacteria, create a crisp crust and a soft, open crumb with a distinctive tangy flavour and chewy texture.

"Everything starts with a traditional approach, quality flour and time," he said.

"Long fermentation makes the bread more digestible and allows a greater depth of flavour and texture to develop."

From flakey croissants to buttery danishes, golden cruffins, cinnamon scrolls and fruit-filled tarts — every pastry at Walter's is made by hand, fresh each morning.

"We don't cut corners, and we don't use margarine — just real ingredients, traditional methods, and the kind of care you can taste," David said.

Call in for a coffee and a warm croissant straight from the oven. The cafe on Currie Street is where locals drop in for sourdough, pastries and a chat.

Andrew has attained a WSET Level 3 in Spirits, a qualification held by only a very small group in Australia.

He has developed a range of exceptional gin using traditional methods of distilling, with no chemicals or additives, and infused with unique local botanicals.

"I like to think my gin sings the song of

Australia," Andrew said.

The Twelve & a Half Acres range offers a taste experience deeply rooted in Australia's vibrant landscapes.

"My gin can be savoured neat or mixed into your favourite cocktail. Each gin in the product range offers a distinct, inspired flavour profile," he said. "Whether it's our Montville Dry Gin with its rich pepper berry notes or our Lemon Myrtle Gin that's perfect for a classic gin sling cocktail, we've got a taste to tantalise every palate."

As testimony to the fact that Twelve and a Half Acres spirits reflect the landscape of Australia, Qantas have picked up the Montville Dry Gin to be served in the Brisbane Business Lounge.

"The garden under the trees has become a firm favourite for mums with little ones,

and we welcome four legged friends as well. We are very happy for people to hang out here and we never chase people away," she said.

Thrill Hill Waterslides

Old-school thrills, cool new memories

Since 1979, Thrill Hill Waterslides in Woombye has been delivering splash-tastic fun to families across the Sunshine Coast. Just 2km north of the Big Pineapple, it remains the region's only dedicated waterslide park—an old-school favourite that continues to delight a new generation of thrillseekers.

"We call it the best value 50 minutes of fun on the Coast," says owner Richard Law. "And judging by how many people come back year after year, we must be doing something right."

At the heart of the park is a 120-metre dynamic hydro slipslide, designed for maximum exhilaration with minimum risk. "It's

exciting, but also safe," says Richard. "The pool is only 900mm deep—so no swimming experience is needed. Everyone just slides in, laughs, and lines up again."

Energy therapy is also available for pets recovering from illness or surgery, or those living with anxiety or chronic pain. These sessions aim to improve the animal's quality of life and help the owner feel more connected to their pet during vulnerable times. Energy therapy can also be used prior to competition to help prepare the pet mentally for their competition ritual.
