Time with God

To Know God through His word and prayer.

Time with Spouse

To make radiant, to promote health and strength, to foster love and to cherish.

Time with Children

To Train in God's Word and in godliness.

Look it up: Deuteronomy 6:4-7; Proverbs 6:20; Ephesians 6:4; 1 Timothy 5:4; Titus 2:4-5



Time with Parents

To learn, love and grow.

Look it up: Deuteronomy 6:4-7; Proverbs 6:20; Ephesians 6:1-3; 1 Timothy 5:4



Time at Work

To gain material provision and to witness about Christ.

Look it up: Proverbs 14:23; Ephesians 4:28; Colossians 3:23-24; 1 Thessalonians 2:9; 2 Thessalonians 3:10; 1 Timothy 5:8



Time with Unsaved People

To witness in word and deed.

Look it up: Proverbs 11:30; Matthew 28:19; 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10;
Philippians 1:18



Time with Saved People

To build up others and to be built up.

Look it up: 1 Corinthians 12:7; Ephesians 4:15-16; Galatians 6:1;
Hebrews 10:24-25



Time at Rest

To get refreshed in order to continue doing God's work well.

Look it up: Genesis 2:2; Exodus 23:12; Mark 6:30-31
