



Methodology: polling

- J.L. Partners polled likely voters in three key swing states; Arizona, Georgia and Wisconsin
 - Fieldwork dates of 27th November 1st December 2023
 - Sample of 550 likely voters for each state

Georgia	135	90	225	100
Wisconsin	135	90	225	97


- Quotas were added to ensure representative data: on gender, age, education, partisan registration, race, congressional district, 2020 vote, and participation in previous primary elections
- The sample was weighted back to the population using data on the same variables: on gender, age, education, partisan registration, race, congressional district, 2020 vote, and participation in previous general elections
 - 3-minute duration
 - Margin of error: 4.2% for each state

Voting intention




Voting intention full slate: Trump leads in Arizona and Georgia, Biden ahead in Wisconsin

Voting intention full slate without Don't Know and Would Not Vote: RFK Jr reaches 7% in Wisconsin


If the presidential election was tomorrow, who would you vote for?

If the presidential election was tomorrow, who would you vote for?


