# Likely voters polling: voting questions 

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## Methodology and summary of findings

## Methodology: polling

J.L. Partners polled a nationally representative sample of 984 likely voters.

- Fieldwork dates of $15^{\text {th }}-20^{\text {th }}$ December 2023, with change shown on $12^{\text {th }}-15^{\text {th }}$ June $2023,15^{\text {th }}-20^{\text {th }}$ September and $10^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ October 2023
- Sample of 984 likely voters
- Sample collected using mixed methods
- Live landline call for 234 responses ( $24 \%$ )
- Live mobile call for 159 responses(16\%)
- SMS for 391 responses ( $40 \%$ )
- In-app for 200 responses (20\%)
- Quotas were added to ensure representative data:
- On region, 2020 presidential vote, partisan ID, age, gender, ethnicity, education, density and participation in previous general elections
- The sample was weighted back to the population using data on the same variables:
- On region, 2020 presidential vote, partisan ID, age, gender, ethnicity, education, density and participation in previous general elections
- 3-minute duration
- Margin of error: $3.1 \%$


## Headline voting intention

## Donald Trump has a 4-point lead over Joe Biden, with RFK Jr on 4\%

If the presidential election was tomorrow, who would you vote for?

## Trump leads by 3 points with Independents

## Trump is holding onto more of his vote than Biden is, with a significant number of Biden voters undecided

## Only 2\% of Trump's 2020 support is going to RFK Jr

If the presidential election was tomorrow, who would you vote for?


## Nationally, Biden is losing slightly more than Trump is to RFK Jr, as well as losing 4\% of his 2020 voters to Trump directly

## The year in review for Trump vs Biden

## Biden was 2 points ahead in June, now Trump is 3 points ahead

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## Trump has increased his vote with Independents while Biden has fallen back amongst Democrats

## Biden has seen his lead go down most sharply with 18-29 year olds, but has gained a lead amongst over-65s

## Biden's lead with Black voters is essentially unchanged since June, but Trump has built a double-digit lead with White voters

## An 11-point Biden lead amongst women in June has fallen to a 6point Biden lead in December

## Biden has lost almost twenty points of support with 18-29 year old women since June
