



Although they are relatively new volunteers, Laura Eldred and Michael Glass have already gained a breadth of knowledge about the behind-the-scenes work of running Eagle Island.

Laura first volunteered in the summer of 2021 to help with the transition, as sleepaway campers left their families to head for the boat launch and the unknowns of Island camp life. She recruited Michael as a volunteer later in the summer to help with closing down the camp. In the fall they volunteered again to store camp items to protect them from freezing over the winter. And in January, Michael had his first snowshoeing experience across the ice to the Island to help Bob Goodsell with taking measurements for an egress from the second floor above the kitchen. More recently, Michael has been learning the intricacies of the camp's sophisticated water system. And both Laura and Michael are active on the Adirondack Committee.

Now that they both have volunteered for the camp, they've seen up close its significance and the importance of preserving it: both as a camp for young people as well as as a historic landmark and Adirondack Great Camp. But more importantly, they have witnessed the dedication of the people working behind the scenes to keep the camp running and viable, and are excited to be part of this dedicated group.

What's your go-to guilty pleasure? Impulsively buying clothes for a toddler, even when I know they will grow out of them quickly.




Land Acknowledgement Recognizing the Traditional Stewards of Eagle Island

This legacy inspired Buz to connect with the group that was working to save our camp in November of 2010. From the very first day, he never gave up on the goal to acquire and reopen Eagle Island and enthusiastically participated in all our campaigns, serving as a Board Member and even acting as a plaintiff in our lawsuit to stop the private sale of the Island. Buz loved the Adirondacks, and for years he brought children to our mountains and taught them about nature, some of which he had learned from his lifelong friends, the Fadden family of the Six Nations Iroquois Cultural Center. So it is a perfect tribute to rename and dedicate our Eagle Island Nature Trail to Henry "Buz" Graves. In this way, all future campers will know the name of this generous friend and his spirit and legacy will always live on his beloved Eagle Island.



Interview with Katie Benson Cook by Anna Nelson

Katie Benson Cook recalls the time she spent at Eagle Island as the "privilege of her childhood." Niece of Pete Benson, longtime camp caretaker, she spent six weeks every summer from fourth through eighth grade at Eagle Island along with her sister, Patti.

Today she still uses the leadership skills learned during those summers in her everyday life, calling on the "can-do spirit" of Eagle Island campers, in particular as a teacher of children with special needs. At camp, she learned about being flexible with a change of plans when it rained and they could not go sailing. The impromptu sing-a-longs would be held indoors instead, and even to this day she fondly sing-a-longs on rainy days. She also learned how to sail at Eagle Island, and still sails today in the Gulf of Mexico near her home in Corpus Christi, Texas.

As an adult, Katie attended a number of Women's Weekends and Family Camp with her husband and son so they too could experience the Island. She returned to Eagle Island after almost a decade last June, and was heartened to find it much the same as the camp she remembers from her childhood. She will be sure to return again.
