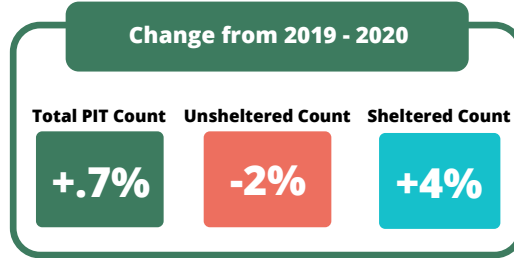

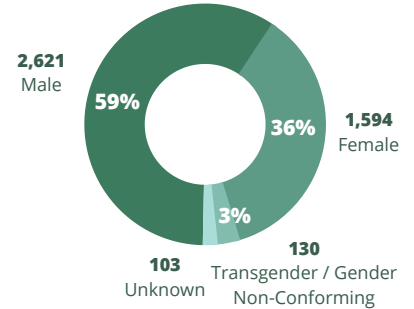

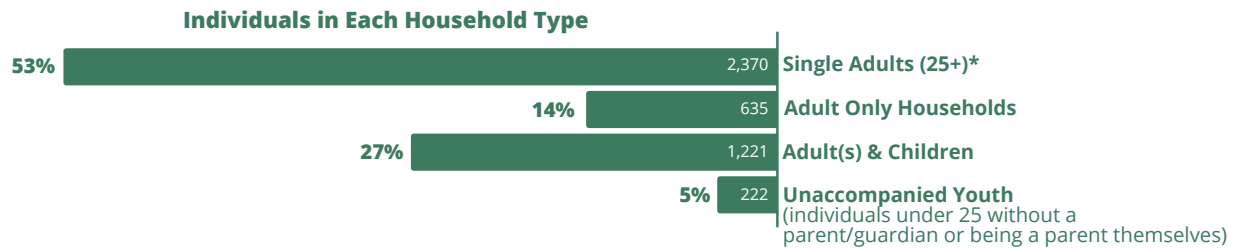

- Methodology: Unsheltered were surveyed and observed 1 day on January 23, 2020. Observations were based on HUD tool that collects important demographic information for those who refuse or cannot be surveyed by volunteers. Survey was administered by a mobile app this year. Shelter data was pulled from HMIS.
- Overall, the total homeless population in the Point In Time Count has not changed drastically over the past two years. After rising steadily from 2011 – 2015, the PIT Count total has decreased by 10% since its peak in 2017.
- Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islanders (NHPI) (31%) and Multiracial individuals (25%) made up the largest percentages of the PIT Count population.
- 82% of Multiracial individuals indicated having NHPI racial background. 51% of the overall PIT Count identified NHPI as either their only race or part of their multiracial background.
 - NHPIs were over-represented by 210%
