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PREFACE

The Vermont Healthcare Emergency Preparedness Coalition (VHEPC) will utilize a Multi-Year Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP) to prioritize and improve our integrated preparedness program to meet the healthcare preparedness and response goals and objectives that align with the Office of the Assistant Secretary of Preparedness and Response (ASPR). The five mission areas of prevention, protection, mitigation, response, and recovery will help VHEPC to work towards the National Preparedness Goal by validating coalition-level plans in conjunction with other state, local, and internal and external stakeholders.

VHEPC has adopted the Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) for standard exercise implementation and evaluation. Exercises should be designed so that each one increases in complexity and scope from previous exercises, based on the HSEEP progressive approach. Use of the progressive approach ensures a successful progression in exercise complexity and allows for the appropriate training and preparation to occur prior to participation in exercises.

The years covered under this IPP include July 1, 2021– June 30, 2024. It is the role of the VHEPC Readiness and Response Coordinator, with guidance from the Vermont Department of Health, to administer the IPP. Members and partners of the VHEPC will participate in the training and exercise program.




Figure 1. HSEEP Integrated Preparedness Cycle

MISSION

The Vermont Healthcare Emergency Preparedness Coalition is a multi-disciplinary partnership that collaborates with its members, stakeholders, and surrounding communities to improve and expand emergency preparedness, response, and recovery capabilities.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the VHEPC's Multi-Year Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP) is to document the coalition's overall planning, training, and exercise program priorities for July 2021-June 2024. This plan is a living document that will be updated and refined annually. The plan is subject to change based on a variety of factors, including but not limited to: real world events, funding, and grant guidance. These priorities are linked to corresponding Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP) capabilities, and, if applicable, a rationale based on existing strategic guidance, threat assessments, corrective actions from previous exercises, or other factors. This IPP identifies the planning, training and exercises that will assist VHEPC in building and sustaining the healthcare preparedness and response capabilities needed to address its training and exercise program priorities.

This IPP identifies a combination of progressively building exercises – along with the associated training requirements – which address the priorities identified by VHEPC Coalition Members and partners. A progressive, multi-year exercise program will enable the VHEPC to participate in a series of increasingly complex exercises, with each successive exercise building upon the previous one until mastery is achieved. Further, by including training requirements in the planning process, the VHEPC can address known shortfalls prior to exercising capabilities.

Where possible and appropriate, the VHEPC will partner with state and local agencies to leverage training and exercise opportunities in an effort to reduce duplication of efforts.

This IPP includes an integrated preparedness schedule, which outlines the proposed planning, training and exercise activities scheduled for July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2024. *It is important to note that due to Vermont's COVID-19 response efforts, VHEPC did not conduct a separate IPPW; VHEPC participated in the State of Vermont's IPPW in July 2021.*

The <u>2017-2022 Healthcare Preparedness and Response Capabilities</u> document outlines the high-level objectives that the nation's healthcare delivery system, including healthcare coalitions (HCCs) and individual healthcare organizations, should undertake to prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies.

The following is a description of the four HPP capabilities, including a brief description of the importance of that capability to the VHEPC.

VHEPC Preparedness Capabilities:

- **1.** Capability 1: Foundation for Healthcare & Medical Readiness
 - The community's health care organizations and other stakeholders coordinated through a sustainable HCC—have strong relationships, identify hazards and risks, and prioritize and address gaps through planning, training, exercising, and managing resources.
- 2. Capability 2: Healthcare & Medical Response Coordination
 - Health care organizations, the VHEPC, and the Vermont Department of Health (ESF-8 lead agency) plan and collaborate to share and analyze information, manage and share resources, and coordinate strategies to deliver medical care to all populations during emergencies and planned events.

3. Capability 3: Continuity of Healthcare Service Delivery

 Health care organizations, with support from the VHEPC and the Vermont Department of Health, provide uninterrupted, optimal medical care to all populations in the face of damaged or disabled health care infrastructure. Health care workers are well-trained, well-educated, and well-equipped to care for patients during emergencies. Simultaneous response and recovery result in a return to normal or, ideally, improved operations.

4. Capability 4: Medical Surge

- Health care organizations—including hospitals, emergency medical services (EMS), and out- of-hospital providers—deliver timely and efficient care to their patients even when the demand for health care services exceeds available supply. The VHEPC, in collaboration with the Vermont Department of Health, coordinates information and available resources for its members to maintain conventional surge response.

In an effort to leverage training and exercise efforts around the state, the VHEPC will align the trainings and exercise identified in the multi-year schedule with Core Capabilities, Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP), and Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP) Capabilities. Any VHEPC-sponsored trainings and exercises will ensure that capabilities are identified for HPP, PHEP and Core Capabilities, utilizing the following capabilities crosswalk.

Training Goals

- Develop and provide Coalition Emergency Operations Plan and Annex Training
- Coordinate training at the coalition-level that aligns with identified coalition hazards/gaps and workplan activities.
- Coordinate routine training on existing technology/communications platforms

Exercise Goals

- Drill existing communications/technology platforms
- Validate coalition response plan/annexes annually through tabletop exercises
- Build on the Coalition Surge Test (updated in 2021 by ASPR to be titled the Medical Response and Surge Exercise) to validate medical surge capabilities

The VHEPC will align training and exercises with the ASPR focus areas (i.e., pediatrics, burn, infectious disease, radiation, and chemical).

Methodology and Tracking

Trainings and exercises were identified based on the gaps identified during the annual Coalition Hazard and Vulnerability Assessment Workshop. VHEPC utilizes the progressive approach and incorporates appropriate trainings throughout the process.

The Readiness and Response Coordinator for VHEPC serves as the Point of Contact for coalition-sponsored trainings and exercises and is required to provide a quarterly training and exercise progress report as well as a corrective action progress report to Vermont Department of Health.

All currently scheduled trainings and exercises will be housed on the coalition website calendar, <u>https://www.vhepcoalition.org/calendar</u>. We recommend bookmarking and checking the website often to see current training and exercise information/registration details.

PLAN MAINTENANCE

In order to provide an effective training and exercise program, the VHEPC IPP will be updated annually by:

- Performing and/or participating in Integrated Preparedness Planning Workshops and/or Work Group meetings.
- Reviewing assessments, including the Coalition Hazard Vulnerability Analysis (HVA), VDH's Joint Risk Assessment (JRA), stakeholder Threat and Hazard Identification Risk Assessment (THIRA)/Stakeholder Preparedness Review (SPR) and After-Action Reports/Improvement Plans (AARIP).
- Reviewing input from partners, state leadership and policy group officials.
- Review federal documents such as the National Preparedness Report, Notice of Funding Opportunities, and information bulletins.

The VHEPC has an active Integrated Preparedness Planning Work Group that convenes monthly and is responsible for annual revisions to this plan.
